This amendment 002 is raised to publish questions and answers, modified Floor plans of the Annex A-2 and modified Annex B.

1) QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q.1:

In Annex A-2 you refer to the a base panel of 36" and seated height add-on of 18". Please confirm that these are approximate sizes and that you are allowing height ranges as described under the SA.

A.1:

The total height of a Seated Privacy Height panel can be achieved with a Base Panel Height and one Panel Add-on Module, and does not exceed 1372mm (54") high. The panels must be electrified in the bottom of the panel thus, below the working surface.

Q.2:

Can you please provide layouts that indicate the location of top feed and or base feeds as well as the location of the powered panels, electrical/communications outlets?

A.2:

The electrified pannels of types A (54 inches) has to contain 2 duplex and the panels of type B (24 inches) 1 duplex. See revised plans.

Q.3:

The RFP states (page 28) that Phase 2 of the project is to supply and install 180 station in the winter of 2018 however the table on page 33 only shows delivery for phase 2.
Is installation to take place in phase 2 or just delivery?

A.3:

Q.4:

The plans provided do not clearly indicate the panel types as described in the text of the RFP.
Can you please provide a correct color legend or corrected layout indicating the A,B,C,D,E and F panel types?

Q.5:

On pages 29 and 30 of the RFP you require that 80 stations be installed in a 2 day period.
This is not a reasonable time. We would require a minimum of 4 days. Is this acceptable?

A.5:

Unfortunately, the installation have do be made during week-end (2 days) because spaces are accupied by employees and it is not possible to interrupt the service or to do it during the hours of service

Q.6:

In the table on page 33 under Phase 3, is the pick up and delivery blank space in the wrong row of the table?

2.2 d) You ask to sypply the plans for the furniture. Given that your request describes the needs for the acoustic screens, we conclude that from it we supply plans illustrating acoustic screens only. Other parts of furniture such as towers and adjustable tables will not be illustrated on the plans. Please specify.

There seems to be some discrepancies between the autocad plan vs elevation drawing (Annex A-2). For example, panels with privacy screens are only shown for 54" wide panels but in the AutoCAD drawings there are also 24" wide that requests privacy screens.

Are we okay to assume that the AutoCAD drawings take precedence over Annex A-2 in terms of the requirement?

A.11:

The appendix A-2 contains panels intimacy in position sat on the panel 54 and 24 inches.

Q.12:

On the AutoCAD drawings, panels are shown in 1 of 4 colours (Orange, Blue, Green, and Yellow). Please advise what each colour represent, as there are no legends to indicate this on the drawing.

Also on AutoCAD drawings, there are no indication of where the power needs to be for each office, please advise.

Please advise if power supply is to be Ceiling feed or Base feed? And what are their locations with in the floor plan?

Q.15: How many duplexes are required per office?

A.15: The electified pannels of types A (54 inches) has to contain 2 duplex and the panels of type B (24 inches) 1 duplex

- b. The Bidder must bid only the products listed in its SA that conform to the requirement listed in this RFP.
- c. Bid prices for the products must not exceed the ceiling unit prices/rates listed in the Supplier's SA.
- d. For PSAB procurements, the bid must comply with the Canadian Content provision stipulated in the Supplier's SA.
- e. The total amount of Applicable Taxes must be shown separately.
- f. If delivery is requested, prices must be DDP Incoterms®2010. If delivery is not requested, prices must be FCA Incoterms® 2010.
