**Part A: Questions**

**Question 1**

Are there drawings available for existing Range and buildings unto which the new 100m Range is to be attached? Are these drawings available in hard copy only or are there digital files available also?

**Response 1**

Yes record drawings do exist for the range complex for reference. Some digital copies do exist. Site conditions must be evaluated on site.

**Question 2**

Page 5 of 81, item 2.4.12 states – “Aggressive project schedule for both design (8 months) and construction (12 months)”. However when reviewing the Schedule in PD 7.1 its confusing as to what some of the timelines are or if they are running concurrently, as it just states “Milestone” or a duration in months.

**Response 2**

See below revised and reformatted schedule to clarify stage durations.

### **Question 3**

Security Clearance Processing has been identified as having a 3 month duration. Will design work be permitted to commence during this period? Is this included in or in addition to the 8 months allocated for design?

### **Response 3**

No, work identified within this solicitation cannot commence until clearances are complete. Once a consultant has a clearance then they can start work. For example the Prime consultant team may have clearance before other engineers which would allow them to start work while waiting for the other consultants to get their clearance.

### **Question 4**

Is the 3 months allocated for Sequential Construction Tendering included in or in addition to the 12 months to get to Substantial Completion? Similarly how does the 1-3 months for Contractor Security Clearances fit in?

### **Response 4**

No, sequential tendering in the schedule is identified with a different duration from contractor security Clearances. See revised and reformatted schedule in Response 2 for clarification.

### **Question 5**

Is the 3 months allocated for BCC/FFE and tenant installations/Commissioning included in or in addition to the 12 months to get to Substantial, recognizing that for some contracts in order for Substantial to be awarded the building must be fully commissioned?

### **Response 5**

The 3 months allocated for BCC/FFE is in addition to the 12 months of construction. Commissioning of the building must take place in the 12 months of construction. See revised and reformatted schedule in Response 2 for clarification.

### **Question 6**

Rather than stating "Milestone" in PD 7.1, could specific dates be provided?

### **Response 6**

The schedule has been defined with duration instead of dates due to the fact that dates change based on actual contract award and issuing of security clearances dates. Durations work to define the time periods we are targeting for the various phases of the projects. See revised and reformatted schedule in Response 2 for clarification.

### **Question 7**

Can the Prime Consultant (Proponent) be an Engineering Firm?

### **Response 7**

No, as the solicitation identifies the Prime Consultant must consist of an Architectural Firm with the qualifications defined in the Evaluation Submission Requirements and Evaluation section and have the ability to deliver services defined within this solicitation.

### **Question 8**

Page 15 of 27, Appendix B, "Size of Organization": there is a field that states "Graduate Architects / Professional Engineers" Question: Does "Graduate Architects" mean Registered Architects?

### **Response 8**

Graduate Architect refers to an individual with a degree in architecture. The solicitation asked for licensed Architects in the province of Saskatchewan as per SRE 3.1.1.

### **Question 9**

Page 10 of 27, Security Requirements for Canadian Supplier: Number 1 states "The Contractor/Offeror must, at all times during the performance of the Contract/Standing Offer, hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS), issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC)"

Question: IF we submit a proposal as a Joint Venture, does the Joint Venture require a DOS - or just the individual firms that are a part of the Joint Venture?

### **Response 9**

A joint venture must submit a Designated Organization Screening for each firm.

### **Question 10**

Page 17 of 20, Appendix B: B2 states "The Proponent is a Joint Venture and each member of the Joint Venture must provide the Contracting Authority with a completed Federal Contractors Program for Employment Equity - Certification. (Refer to the Joint Venture section of the General Instructions)."

Question: Does each firm of the Joint Venture have to fill out a Federal Contractors Program for Employment Equity - Certification form? Or just one form is required from the Joint Venture?

### **Response 10**

Yes each firm of the joint venture must complete the completed Federal Contractors Program for Employment Equity – Certification.

### **Question 11**

Page 20 of 27, Appendix B, Declaration statement: "If any proposal is submitted by a partnership or joint venture, then the following is required from each component entity" - this is followed by a short form requiring name/signature/title.

Question: Is a separate form required from each firm of the Joint Venture, or is a name from each firm required on one form, or just one name is required on the form who represents the Joint Venture?

### **Response 11**

One form is acceptable.
