The following changes / clarifications in the tender documents are effective immediately. This amendment will form part of the Contract Documents.

**Response to Bidders' Inquiries:**

Please find below a response to bidder's inquiries received to date.

- 1. On the optional 8,000 m<sup>3</sup> of dredging, will the mobilization and demobilization be paid for a second time if we have demobilized after completing the initial 9,000 m<sup>3</sup> of dredging?**

There will be no additional mobilization/demobilization cost if any optional dredging is exercised prior to the contractor demobilizing from site. If any optional dredging is exercised after demobilization from site, the contractor may submit a request for extra work for additional mobilization/demobilization.

- 2. Is there any detail on the required silt curtain for this project in terms of material, total length and other specs?**

If owners representative observes deposition on nearby eelgrass beds, the contractor will ensure the silt curtain's depth, continuity, and integrity are functioning, and/or be required to change operations (i.e. timing (speed), different tide, etc.) to ensure the silt curtain's depth, continuity, and integrity are functioning.

- 3. Is there anymore environmental data such as current speed, wave height, tidal info, wind speeds etc. for site?**

The site information is as provided in tender. Contractor will be responsible for obtaining additional site information if required, and be familiar with the site conditions.

- 4. Is there any more detail that can be provided on the regulatory buoys that will be used to mark marine channels?**

No, buoys/markers shall conform to standards/regulations set by Transport Canada for safe navigation.

**All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.**
