Answers #4

The contractor shall provide for the demolition of the existing hangar and its foundation. Its foundation consists of reinforced concrete including walls (with footings), pillars and a concrete slab. Attached to this document are the original plans for the construction of this building. Only the part of the hangar is demolished.

Question #5

Are the lightweight concrete panels finished with plastering?

Answers #5

No plastering and joint finishing are required as it is an uninsulated and unheated addition.
