1) QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

QUESTION 1:

We would like to inquire about the Worksurface shown in:

Office Type 1, Type de Bureau 1 (OFF 1)

Category_1B,_Catégorie_1B

Will the client accept alternate shapes for this table?

ANSWER 1:

We will not accept alternate shapes for this table.

QUESTION 2:

As per the below visual of the AT1/AT2 height adjustable table grouping you have indicated a single stand-alone power pole.

How is the power and communications to be distributed to the individual tables?

ANSWER 2:

Power and communications distribution to the individual tables are as per the Workspace Specification at Annex a-1 article 5.3 by grommets, article 5.6 by wire management which conceal electrical and data cabling.

QUESTION 3:

Requesting to extend the deadline a minimum of one week from the date of receipt of answers.

ANSWER 3:

See amendment 001.

QUESTION 4:

Could you please confirm the ceiling height on each of the floors? This is required to determine the correct power pole length.

ANSWER 4:

2570 mm is the average height to underside of suspended ceiling.

QUESTION 5:

WS1 - Are metal workstation accessories acceptable?

ANSWER 5:

Yes.

QUESTION 6:

WS1 - Are the height adjustable tables to be specified with a center grommet to accept the grommet mount monitor arm? If not, will an edge clamp monitor be acceptable?

ANSWER 6:

The height adjustable tables that are specified with a center grommet is to accept the grommet mount monitor arm.

QUESTION 7:

WS1 - Could you please confirm the make-up of panels E and F? Are there supposed to be whiteboard elements located outside of the workstations?

ANSWER 7:

Yes, there is supposed to be a whiteboard elements located outside of the workstations for typical WS1. Please refer to the rules within Annex e

- a) The floor plan takes precedent over any discrepancies.
- b) When two or more typical workstation types share a common panel spine, the finishes of the interior side of the workstation panel as outlined in the Typical Data Sheets must be followed and **NO PANELS SHALL BE DOUBLED. Where no workstation exists adjacent to typical workstation, refer to Data Sheet for finish.**

Should one typical workstation identify power and the other does not – power will be required for both.

QUESTION 8:

WS2/WS3 - Are the benching worksurfaces to be specified with a center grommet (for each side) to accept the grommet mount monitor arm?

ANSWER 8:

Yes, the benching work surfaces is specified with a center grommet (for each side) to accept the grommet mount monitor arm.

QUESTION 9:

WS2/WS3/WS4 - Item A - Unable to find GoCUID# BPxxFFLHRxxxx4Dxx7248, could the correct number be GoCUID# BPxxFFLHRxxxx4D7248?

QUESTION 10 :

WS2/WS3/WS4 - Privacy screens being requested are not to be used in benching applications. GoCUID# ACPRSMAXxxxxx1836. In the SA document Annex A-1 3.5 - requirement for screens is that they mount to the top of a panel, the edge of a worksurface that is panel mounted and to freestanding worksurfaces. Benching is a different description, therefore requesting that they be removed or changed to non-SA product.

ANSWER 10 :

All Privacy screens for the benching application are removed from this requirement.

QUESTION 11:

WS4 - According to the rules of the SA, the Cat. 2 Height Adjustable Tables could possibly be awarded to a different supplier than Cat. 1. For this reason there may be compatibility issues between the table and the screens. Please advise how suppliers are to ensure these items work together or remove them from the immediate requirement.

ANSWER 11:

The SA rules states; **RULE:** Category 1 and 2

Category 1 and 2 can be combined for tier 2 and tier 3 requirements when Category 2 surfaces comprise no more than 50% of the total sum of work surfaces.

PSPC is taking the option of bundling cat 1&2 together.

QUESTION 12:

WS5/WS6 - The SA specification documents did not have a provision for power poles in Category 2. Also, there wasn't a requirement for power to run from one height adjustable table to another. Please confirm that power poles are not to be provided by the supplier of the Height Adjustable tables and that the power for each of these tables is independent of the other tables.

ANSWER 12:

Correct, the power poles are not to be provided by the supplier, please refer to A#2 for additional information.

QUESTION 13:

WS6 - Please confirm whether the request is for a single or dual monitor arm for this typical. The drawing is showing a single monitor arm, where the list of comments C is stating a dual monitor arm.

ANSWER 13:

The 1220 mm wide workstations are intended to have only a single monitor arm due to the width. The dual monitor arm in the description should read single.

QUESTION 14:

OFF 1 - Could you please confirm the height of item B - Low Storage - Credenza Unit being requested for this office?

ANSWER 14:

The client would prefer an approx. height of 20", the Workspace Annex A-1 states at article 7.6 The low storage/credenza units must be capable of being located beneath a fixed height work surface when partially supporting a work surface and when a seat cushion is not required.

The height of the low storage/credenza units must not exceed 797mm (31 in.).

QUESTION 15:

OFF 1 - Item B - Unable to find GoCUID# SPLSSLxRxxxxOxxx7224, could the correct number be GoCUID# SPLSSSLxRxxxxOx7224?

ANSWER 15:

Delete GoCUID# SPLSSLxRxxxxOxxx7224 and replace with SPLSSSLxRxxxxOxxx7224

OFF 1/OFF 2 - Item C - Unable to find GoCUID# SPHxSSLxRxxxxOxxx7215, could the correct number be GoCUID# SPHxSSLxRxxxxOx7215?

OFF 2 - Item B - Unable to find GoCUID# SPLSSSLxRDDFFCDxx7224, could the correct number be GoCUID# SPLSSSLxRDDFFCD7224?

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QUESTION 18 :

OFF 1/OFF 2 - Could you please confirm the height of the Hutch being requested for this office. As per the typical provided, the top of the hutch looks like it coincides with the storage cabinet being requested (72"H). The maximum height for a high storage unit (such as hutches) in Category 1B is 54"H.

ANSWER 18 :

The client would prefer an approx. height of 33.5" but we will accept what is stated in the Workspace Annex A-1 specification at article;

7.7.1 High storage units installed onto a low storage/credenza unit must not exceed a combined height of 1372mm (54 in.) with the exception of Category 4 – Wood Veneer – Freestanding Products.

7.7.2. When a hutch is used to make a high storage unit the overall height of the hutch plus the low storage/credenza unit must not exceed 1372mm (54 in.), with the exception of Category 4 – Wood Veneer – Freestanding Products.

QUESTION 19:

. Is it possible to have clear indication on the floor plans which typical workstation is where? The floor plans show locations of furniture systems power poles, however in some cases their location does not make sense. ie. Question 10 (above), where workstation typicals consist of only height adjustable tables with no power requirement. Also in situations for benching products (Tower 3.3, A4, workstations W103, W123, W124, W130, W131, W137), there seems to be a gap/space between the benches and the furniture systems power poles. Clarification is required.

ANSWER 19:

WS1 - See detail 02 on all plans – example is T3-3-W098 – Qty. 6 per floor plate

WS2 - Benches are coded as B1 on plans – example is T3-3-W123/T3-3-W101 (two work ids per typical)

WS3 - Benches are coded as B2 on plans – example is T3-3-W087 (one work id per typical)

WS4 - Benches are not shown on plans – there is a blank space on plans as these are not in contract (not available in the SA) and will be purchased separately. Its pretty easy to figure out where these go – example is T3-3-W124/T3-3-W103 (two work ids per typical)

WS5 - Tables are coded as AT1 on plans – example is T3-3-W139 (one work id per typical)

WS6 - Tables are coded as AT2 on plans with exception of ones in workstations WS1 as AT2 is a part of WS1 and WS6 - example is T3-3-W145 (one work id per typical)

OFF1 - Desks are coded as D1, Credenza as D1 and Hutch as D4 (example would be office T3-3-225) – Qty. 5 per floor plate

OFF2 - Desks are coded as D1, Credenza as D3 and Hutch as D4 (example would be office T3-3-235) – Qty. 1 per floor plate

QUESTION 20:

Category 1B - Non-SA products - Where are these to be located? A clear indication of their location and application is necessary in order to include these in the bid.

ANSWER 20:

Non SA products are removed from this requirement.
