**This amendment is raised to answer questions and make the following modifications:**

**Questions and answers:**

1. Can you tell me what range of building types may be involved in the call-ups? Will these primarily be offices? Would they be mostly renovations or would there be some new buildings under consideration?
  - a. There will be a mixture of projects dependent on future needs of PSPC and clients, and may contain assignments for office fit-ups, renovations of existing facilities and new buildings.
2. Would there be facilities for First Nations included?
  - a. There may be projects with office fit-ups or renovations of existing facilities for Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada
3. I am also asking if there would be involvement of third party facility and project managers?
  - a. There may be projects with office fit-ups or renovations of existing facilities within an existing facility which is managed by a third party.
4. On page 7 item GI2 - The paragraph states that, "Proponents shall be licensed or eligible to be licensed to practise in the province governing each applicable zone or zones (i.e. Alberta, Saskatchewan and/or Manitoba). If a Proponent is licensed to practise in only one of the three provinces, then that Proponent must be eligible and willing to be licensed in the province in which they are not licensed."

Does the registration in more than one province apply to all Proponents or is the registration requirement only if you are applying for the Standing Offer in zones within a province or provinces that the Proponent is currently not registered in?

- a. The registration requirement only applies for the zones the proponent is bidding on and that the Proponent is currently not registered in.
5. Further to our Question 1 above, can a Proponent apply to only the zones within the province in which the Proponent is currently registered? Page 54 item 2.2 appears to indicate that a proponent can respond to one zone only, if that is all they want to respond to.
  - a. Yes, the Proponent can apply on any number or combination of zones.
6. Do we need to nominate sub-consultants (Electrical, Mechanical, Structural, Civil etc.)
  - a. Sub-consultants are not required to be included in the proposal for the Standing Offer.
7. Should we refer to the client as Public Services and Procurement Canada (PSPC) or by Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC)
  - a. Either is acceptable. Note that PWGSC is referenced in the RFSO.

8. How is the overall price for the Financial Bid calculated? Is it based upon the "Total Blended cost for a 1,000 hour project" (for the period of October 01, 2017 to September 31, 2018) or are the rates for the three time periods added together?
  - a. The overall evaluated price is calculated by adding the Total Blended cost for the three time periods.
9. Are Consultant teams allowed to propose a team that has some personnel that work in multiple zones, with the others being responsible for single zones?
  - a. Yes
10. For personnel that are identified for multiple zones: are they to be identified for ALL additional zones, or can they be identified for any number of additional zones?
  - a. For personnel being identified for multiple zones, they can be identified for any number of zones. It needs to be clear for which zones the personnel is being presented for.
11. I would like to know if the 3 projects the Proponent must propose in section 3.2.3 under the SRE should be similar to the projects that are outlined in section 1.2.3 of the TOR?
  - a. The projects required under Section 3.2.3 is not required to be the same as 1.2.3 of the TOR. It is for the proponent to showcase their firm's talents and success on projects.

**Modification:**

**On page 7, Delete item GI2 Article 3 and replace with the following:**

3. It is PWGSC's intention to authorize up to twenty (20) Standing Offers, four (4) in each zone, Northern and Southern Alberta, Northern and Southern Saskatchewan, and Manitoba, each for a period of three (3) years from the date of issuing the Standing Offers. The total dollar value of all Standing Offers is estimated to be \$21,000,000.00 (Applicable Taxes included). Individual call-ups will vary, up to a maximum of \$1,000,000.00 (Applicable Taxes included). Proponents should note that there is no guarantee that the full or any amount of the Standing Offers will be called-up; PWGSC will issue call-ups only when the specific services to be provided under the Standing Offer are needed. Please refer to Section SP5, CALL-UP PROCEDURE.

**All other terms and conditions of the Request for Standing Offer remain unchanged.**
