ADDENDUM #001:

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS FROM OPTIONAL SITE VISIT:

1. What is the main construction access point?
 - a. The security gate on the east side of the facility will be the main access point for the majority of the work.
2. Can the security gates on the west side of the site be used at all?
 - a. The security gates on the southwest and northwest corners of the facility may be used when/if this can be coordinated with the adjacent construction site, and if the phase of construction is in those corners of the facility. If this cannot be coordinated then the east access point will have to be used.
3. What parking is provided at the facility?
 - a. There is no parking available in the facility parking lot. Permits to a limited amount of parking may be available along 174th street; however, alternative parking measures may be required if more parking spaces are required.
4. Why is phasing required for the work?
 - a. The idea of phasing the construction is to reduce security risks. If too much of the existing pavement walkway is removed and the contractor is unable to complete the new concrete sidewalk along the same stretch of fence within a short timeline, this presents a security risk. Things like weather must be taken into account as well. Leaving the existing asphalt pathway ripped up due to poor weather is unacceptable.
5. What protection/security will be required of the construction areas?
 - a. Refer to specs. All areas must be secured to the standards of the facility fencing. Heating and hoarding can also pose as a security risk as tarps are considered high risk items (can be thrown over fence and used to climb over). All tools/equipment/supplies must be locked up when not in use.
6. Does the concrete have to go right up to the top of the 2x6 board underneath the fence?
 - a. Yes, the drawings also specify the maximum spacing allowable between the bottom of the fence and the concrete sidewalk. The height of the sidewalk is to be adjusted in areas where the fencing steps up or down, to keep within this allowable spacing.

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7. Can the 2x6 board underneath the fence be placed on the outside of the fence to reduce the variance in height?
 - a. No, the 2x6 boards must remain directly underneath the fence as the fence must be bolted to this board. The boards look to be in salvageable condition; however, there may be some 2x6 boards that require replacing if they are in poor condition.

 8. Are security clearances specific to the EIFW facility?
 - a. Yes, security clearances between CSC facilities do not correlate. The CPIC process must be completed for each individual facility and each individual crew member accessing the site. This process can take up to one month. The only exceptions will be if delivery trucks or cement trucks (as drivers are usually different) are required on site, they will not require CPIC clearance, but instead will have to be escorted by CSC staff and under supervision at all times.

 9. Can concrete trucks enter the site?
 - a. If there are situations that require the cement truck to enter the site, that truck must be escorted by CSC staff at all times. Without a CSC escort concrete will either have to be pumped in over the fence or hauled in from the access point.

 10. Are there any recommendations for fencing contractors familiar with CSC sites and may be interested in completing the fencing portion of the scope?
 - a. Both Phoenix Fencing and Lynx Fencing were mentioned as having worked on CSC facility fencing in the past.

 11. Where should the new man gate be installed on the north side of the facility?
 - a. CSC wants to install the gate down at the next corner post along the interior fence line. The detection system required on the new gate is not in the scope of the contract and will be installed by CSC.

 12. Where should the new man gate on the south side of the facility be installed?
 - a. Reference drawing "CO1 Overall Plan" for gate location. Corner posts or another type of support may need to be installed to tie into.

 13. Who can complete locates within the facility?
 - a. All locates must be done by a private locator approved by CSC. Details included in the contract.

 14. Will an inspection be required every day for all equipment/tools/supplies on the site?
 - a. All equipment and supplies will be inspected and accounted for when it enters or exits the facility. Tools will need to be accounted for each day and locked in secure storage approved by the Institution. CSC will review the type and size of temporary storage within the site. The successful bidder will be required to submit plans and details for review in the form of a shop drawing prior to bringing to site.

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15. Will a laydown area be allotted?
 - a. Yes, but the location is to be approved by the facility. The laydown area must also be fenced off and meet all security protocols for fencing and securing of equipment/tools/supplies.

16. Does the culvert along the east fence of the facility have to be removed?
 - a. No, the removal of the culvert is to be deleted from the scope of work.

17. Are slip dowels required in the sidewalk?
 - a. Yes, details in the specifications.

18. Where do the lines run under the ground for the security cameras?
 - a. They run parallel with the fence, but should be far enough out to not affect the work on the anti-tunneling sidewalk. A locate will be required to confirm prior to digging. Locates are part of the contract and will require a private locator to complete the work.

19. If the price can be matched, can concrete be used in place of the asphalt planned for the roadway work at the east security gate and/or for the interior road?
 - a. TBD - this is to be confirmed with CSC National Headquarters if this is an acceptable change to the scope. If concrete is an option that the bidder wants to entertain, please provide alternate pricing for the pavement.

20. Can the shape of the interior road be adjusted/improved to appease larger emergency vehicles?
 - a. If approved by CSC, this will be addressed as a Change Order after award. For bidding purposes reference the scope of work in the tender documents.

21. Are there any other security protocols to be aware of?
 - a. Refer to section "01 14 10 Institutional Requirements for Contractors" of the specifications.
