We have insurance documents and for the vessel which we can provide, however we do not have an insurance document from a broker stating that we are licenced to operate in Canada, if we obtain such a document will that suffice?

## **Question #3b**

b. The Bidder must provide a Health and Safety Plan that is consistent with Transport Canada Safety Inspection Certificates or international equivalents.

Client typically prepares HSE Plans upon contract award, they do however have safety inspections certificates for the vessel. Will this be acceptable?
