## 1. Introduction

On October 24th, 2016 the Honorable Jane Philpott, Minister of Health announced that Health Canada is revising Canada's Food Guide (CFG). This revision is part of a multi-year Healthy Eating Strategy, which outlines how Health Canada will achieve commitments set out in the Prime Minister's mandate letter to the Minister of Health. The Healthy Eating Strategy is a component of the vision for a healthy Canada, which focuses on healthy eating, healthy living, and a healthy mind.

## 2. Objective

Health Canada requires a Contractor to design, develop, test, and deploy a solution. This Solution includes user interface, information management, HC employee training, managing the application and supporting a broad, integrated responsive Web Portal that will be used for the Canada Food Guide. This Portal will permit open data usage and mobile innovation. Additional professional services may be required on an "as and when required" basis.

### Security Requirement:

#### SECURITY REQUIREMENT FOR CANADIAN SUPPLIER: PWGSC FILE # COMMON-PS-SRCL#9

1. The Contractor/Offeror must, at all times during the performance of the Contract/Standing Offer/Supply Arrangement, hold a valid Designated Organization Screening (DOS) with approved Document Safeguarding at the level of **PROTECTED B**, issued by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate, Public Works and Government Services Canada.
2. The Contractor/Offeror personnel requiring access to PROTECTED information, assets or work site(s) must EACH hold a valid **RELIABILITY STATUS**, granted or approved by the Canadian Industrial Security Directorate (CISD), Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).
3. The Contractor MUST NOT utilize its Information Technology systems to electronically process, produce or store PROTECTED information until the CISD/PWGSC has issued written approval. After approval has been granted or approved, these tasks may be performed up to the level of **PROTECTED B**.
4. Subcontracts which contain security requirements are NOT to be awarded without the prior written permission of CISD/PWGSC.
5. The Contractor/Offeror must comply with the provisions of the:
  - a. Security Requirements Check List and security guide (if applicable), attached at Annex C;
  - b. *Industrial Security Manual* (Latest Edition).
