Question #1

Identified Users – Can Fisheries and Oceans Canada confirm that Identified Users will be a limited/select number of authorized personnel that will engage with the Offeror for all call outs against the Standing Offer, rather than any and all personnel with the department?

Response #1

We can supply a list of work approvers for call-ups against the Standing Offer upon contract award. This Standing Offer is specific to Real Property and any call-ups against from others within DFO are approved prior to work.

Question #2

Right of First Refusal – Can Fisheries and Oceans Canada confirm the definition of this statement in this specific instance? We assume that for the Standing Offer agreement for all refrigeration and HVAC services at the Pacific Biological Station in Nanaimo, the awarded contractor will be offered all relevant/in-scope work in the first instance, prior to Fisheries and Oceans Canada engaging with any other contractor for completion of required work.

Response #2

Wherever and whenever possible within the terms of the Standing Offer the awarded contractor will be offered the work. Subject to operational requirements, and awarded contractor availability, DFO reserves the right to contract through other means if needed.
