The Bidder must include the following table in their Technical Construction Bid Submission, indicating that their Bid Submission meets the Mandatory Criteria, providing the page number and section that contains information to verify that the criteria has been met or insert the information within the table.

Technical Construction Bid Submissions that do not meet the mandatory criteria will be deemed noncompliant.
