“All Evaluators must be certified by the Bilingualism Institute of the University of Ottawa for CMHC’s Oral Expression (speaking) test. The Evaluators must be able to successfully collect evidence during the test and apply the evidence to the evaluation grid in a manner consistent with the test design. Test must be administered as per testing protocol. The proponent must be able to provide both English and French second language evaluation services.

If required, the proponent will be responsible for all costs related to training on the test offered by the Bilingualism Institute of the University of Ottawa.

The proponent must have sufficient Evaluators (a minimum of three (3) for each - English and French - tests) ready and able to fulfill CMHC testing’s needs for employees and potential employees from across Canada.

The proponent must submit to CMHC for review the certifications and relative experience of all evaluators being proposed. Prior to any change to the evaluation team, the proponent must inform CMHC and provide the certification of the new evaluator.”
