Amendment 04

This Amendment No. 4 is being raised to answer bidder questions and replace the unit price table.

A. Bidder Questions:

Q1 Regarding Section 01 14 00 Ordnance Search; does Parks Canada have a contact list for this type of service, or a contact with DND who may be able to provide this information?

A1 *Canadian Avalanche Association maintains a directory of Professionals which may have this experience. They also have a dedicated website to advertise postings to their members. (<https://www.avalancheassociation.ca/networking/submit.asp>) Additionally, suppliers may make themselves known by becoming an Interested Supplier and registered as such (<https://buyandsell.gc.ca/procurement-data/tenders/get-started/join-a-list-of-interested-suppliers>).*

Q2 May I please ask the size of the existing culvert at the Tupper snowshed, at station 0+606 on drawing 201? Is the length of the damaged portion known at this time?

A2 *The culvert at station 0+606 on Sheet 201 is anticipated to be 900mm and requires a replacement of 3m but the details shall be confirmed in the field with the Departmental Representative prior to ordering any materials.*

Q3 I take it that the topsoil for required for this project is to be made from the stripping which is paid under Roadway Drainage & Excavation. Is this material suitable to produce the required topsoil, and is there enough organic material in the excavation to produce the required amount?

A3 It is anticipated that the material is suitable and available in sufficient quantities to produce the required topsoil provided proper means and methods are utilized to isolate and then process the on-site material.

Q4 Where are we to stockpile the material so we can screen the stripping to produce topsoil?

A4 Interim stockpile sites for processing will be available within the snowshed corridor following consulting with, and approval from, the Departmental Representative. These sites are not available for final stockpiles remaining at the completion of the Works and all material shall be relocated to suitable locations.

Q5 The typical sections for all 4 snow sheds show 2 – 100mm layers of sand bedding and 2 – 100mm layers of topsoil within the prism of the bitumous liner, therefore indicating that the sand quantity and the topsoil quantity should be the same, yet there is 2,300 cubic metres less topsoil in the tender form than sand. Is this a mistake? The sand quantity appears to be correct if you take the 27,500 m² of liner and multiply it by the required 200mm of sand. Should the topsoil not be the same?

A5 Unit Price Item 6 Topsoil Placement and Grading quantity increased to a total of 5,910m³ as per revised ITT.
