## **Amendment 2**

### **Warehouse Mapping and System Install**

This amendment was raised to answer questions:

Questions:

1. Can the underground steam line coffins be utilized to run conduit from the main building to the compound huts?

2. In section F, IT Requirements, subpoint v, it states:

“v.IT drops can be added from either the standalone or the dedicated server. DND (via Shared Services Canada) will install the drops. “

I interpret this as if I require 25 IT drops, DND via Shared Services Canada, will install the 25 drops.

Have I interpreted these accurately?

3. In vi, it states:

“vi. Customer is responsible for installing network/LAN for CMS system for one standalone computer only with outside network capability.”

I interpret this as, if I need that 1 standalone computer to have outside internet access, I'm required to provide that.

Have I interpreted these accurately?

4. In regards to the cost of calibration, our equipment comes with calibration certificates that are valid for 1 year. The RFP states that the contractor must perform an onsite calibration within a year. I interpret this as not required since our equipment is already calibrated unlike other vendors who charge extra for calibration.

Have I interpreted these accurately?

Answers:

1. No

2. The interpretation is not exactly correct. DND/SSC will only install IT drops for DND systems i.e. the fire alarm monitoring system, DWAN and GPNNet. DND/SSC will move the current standalone systems drop. The fact that the Contractor requires 25 IT drops for their system that will be added to standalone system drop that is currently in place is the Contractor's responsibility.

3. Yes if you need a standalone computer to have outside access it is your responsibility.

4. Each instrument used will have a certificate of calibration describing its expiry date. This is when the instrument needs to be recalibrated, so it will have to be recalibrated by this date. The fact is the one year of comprehensive onsite technical support, including calibrations of all data loggers/probes and
