DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Dredging services for Balsam Bay Manitoba and Calders Dock Manitoba

LOCATION OF WORK SITES

Balsam Bay is located on the east shore of Lake Winnipeg approximately 80 kilometers north of Winnipeg. Calders Dock is location on the west shore of Lake Winnipeg, approximately 75 kilometers north of Riverton Manitoba.

FAMILIARIZATION WITH SITES

Before submitting a bid, bidders can visit the sites and their surroundings to review and verify the form, nature and extent of the work, materials needed for the completion of the work, the means of access to the sites, any accommodations they may require, and in general shall obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid or costs to do the work. No allowance shall be made subsequently in this connection on account of error or negligence to properly observe and determine the conditions that will apply. Contractors, bidders, or those they invite to the sites are to review the specification Section 01 35 29 "Health and Safety Requirements" before visiting sites.

EXPECTED START AND COMPLETION DATES

The services of the Contractor will be commencing upon contract award. The expected completion date of this project is **March 15, 2018**.

SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

There are no Security Requirements associated with this requirement.



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MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS:

- The minimum acceptable amount of Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance is **\$2,000,000.00** per occurrence. All tenders **must** be accompanied by confirmation from the tenderer's insurance company that the required insurance will be available upon contract award;
- The tenderer must provide tender security, at the tenderer's own cost, in accordance with the document entitled "Tender Security Requirements" as Bid Security is required for bids over \$100,000. Under these circumstances, the Tender and **original signed Bid Bond** must be delivered to the Closing Location prior to the closing date.

Note: All tender securities (Bid Bond) will be returned except that of the successful tenderer (Bidder), which will be retained until the successful tenderer (Contractor) has completed the said contract.
