Question 1:

The panel elevations call for fabric tiles below the worksurface. We always recommend painted tiles under the surfaces as they are a more durable option.

Will you accept a submission with painted tiles below the worksurface?

Answer 1:

No, please provide fabric elements unless stated otherwise.

Question 2:

We have a question regarding NOCOM. Can you please confirm what this is and if you require the manufacturer to include this in the submission?

2) Product Descriptions

- a. *Panel height: Work Surface Privacy Add-on Height, Seated Privacy Add-on Height (please refer to panel Matrix in section 4).*
- b. *Power is required below the work surface.*
- c. *Type of feed: ceiling feed / power poles. NOCOM Conversion must be included for 35 Power Poles.*
- d. *Each electrical outlet showing on the Plan are Duplex Electrical Outlets.*
- e. *All 42" (and above) work surfaces must have one centered grommet or scallop.*

Answer 2:

NoCom is an electrical “plug and play” system. A conversion box is installed to the end of the power pole and connected a whip which is then connected to a NoCom PDM box installed within the plenum space. The Nocom connections must be supplied and installed by supplier and included in this submission.
