3. Question from Bidder:

We viewed the jobsites, a question for the Calder's Dock site. Attached are 2 pictures of the road leading into the site (Picture 1 is facing South toward the Harbour, Picture 2 is in the same location facing North), on the 2nd picture, behind the truck and to the right is an existing spoil pile from the last time the harbor was dredged. Immediately behind the pile is a 4' to 5' drop off prior to the tree line. Can we dump the spoil material from the harbor on top of / or behind the existing spoil pile? (as seen in picture #2)

DFO Answer 03

The area in the photo and referenced above is not Small Craft Harbours Property. In order to use the proposed location for the spoil pile, Small Craft Harbours would require the contractor to obtain approval from applicable authorities, such as a Work Permit from Manitoba Conservation, that documents the intention to dispose the material at that location.

All other Terms and Conditions for this requirement remain unchanged.
