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The following is in response to inquiries received in relation to this solicitation. This amendment will form part of the contract documents.

Question 1

With respect to GI 2 – Introduction

Could you advise on what historically has been the percentage split on past standing offers between studies/reports and design and construction projects?

Answer 1

PWGSC tracks business volume of individual contracts including amendments. PWGSC does not track the type of services being requested as these services could evolve and change during the life of the contract. Future projects and associated dollar value are unknown.

Question 2

With respect to SP 5 – Regarding the distribution calculation,

- a) Can you clarify how the Ideal Business Distribution System works?
- b) Is the value of a submitted, but not yet accepted proposal, used as part of the distribution calculation?
- c) If so, is there a time period (such as 30 days) in which the proposal must either be accepted or rejected by PSPC?
- d) Is the calculation based only on the initial value of the fees or is it updated if the contract is amended?

Answer 2

- a) It is PWGSC's intent to issue a call-up for all requests. But unfortunately sometimes due to a change in departmental priorities, changes are necessary. In such cases, the Consultant's ideal distributed percentage is readjusted to reflect the changes/cancellation.
