### 3.1 Bid Preparation Instructions

Canada requests that Bidders provide their bid in separately bound sections as follows:

Section I: Technical Bid (1 electronic copy using ePost Connect OR Fax OR 1 hard copy)

Section II: Financial Bid (1 electronic copy using ePost Connect OR Fax OR 1 hard copy)

Section III: Certifications (1 electronic copy using ePost Connect OR Fax OR 1 hard copy)

Bidders who submit an electronic copy using ePost Connect or using fax are not required to submit a hard copy. If both an electronic copy and hard copy are submitted, and there is a discrepancy between the wording of the electronic copy and the hard copy, the wording of the hard copy will have priority over the wording of the electronic copy.

Prices must appear in the financial bid only. No prices must be indicated in any other section of the bid.

Canada requests that Bidders follow the format instructions described below in the preparation of their bid:

- (a) use 8.5 x 11 inch (216 mm x 279 mm) paper;
- (b) use a numbering system that corresponds to the bid solicitation.

In April 2006, Canada issued a policy directing federal departments and agencies to take the necessary steps to incorporate environmental considerations into the procurement process [Policy on Green Procurement](http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/ecologisation-greening/achats-procurement/politique-policy-eng.html) (<http://www.tpsgc-pwgsc.gc.ca/ecologisation-greening/achats-procurement/politique-policy-eng.html>). To assist Canada in reaching its objectives, Bidders should:

- 1) use 8.5 x 11 inch (216 mm x 279 mm) paper containing fibre certified as originating from a sustainably-managed forest and containing minimum 30% recycled content; and
- 2) use an environmentally-preferable format including black and white printing instead of colour printing, printing double sided/duplex, using staples or clips instead of cerlox, duotangs or binders.

#### Section I: Technical Bid

In their technical bid, Bidders should explain and demonstrate how they propose to meet the requirements and how they will carry out the Work.

#### Section II: Financial Bid

Bidders must submit their financial bid in accordance with the Basis of Payment.

Q1. What angle is the spreader bar rated to?

A1. *45 degrees.*

Q2. Should the rigging be adjustable?

A2. *The rigging will not be adjusted. DND will choose rigging for the worst case (furthest apart).*

Q3. For the rigging, does it need to come with shackles to connect the rigging to the bar?

A3. *No; DND will provide the shackles.*
