## QUESTION AND ANSWER SERIES 2

Q16. Carriages Point 9 – Says that the system must maintain the NFPA 13,20.6. But Carriages Point 10 says that the carriages must have 2" bumpers on each side total of 4" gap. This does not meet the NFPA requirements. Can Public Services and Procurement Canada (PSPC) please confirm this requirement?

A16. The system must conform to NFPA 13, article 20.6 (Compact Storage of Commodities Consisting of Paper Files, Magazines, Books, and Similar Documents in Folders and Miscellaneous Supplies with No More Than 5 Percent Plastics Up to 8 ft (2.4 m) High.) There is nothing in that article that references bumper depth, only the maximum height of the units, spacing above for sprinklers, minimum steel gauge of units, maximum unit footprint, and minimum aisle width (700mm). Carriages are to conform to these standards.

The 'Carriages' Point 10 should be revised to read:

Include 12.7 mm(1/2") bumpers on each side of each carriage (moving or fixed) providing a 25.4 mm(1 in) gap between each carriage.

Q17. If the Bidder arranges the filing system with the 4" gap on all the systems; the size of the entire system exceeds the allotted space on the layouts. Can PSPC confirm if the 4" gap, or the size of the room takes precedence when submitting a bid?

A17. The maximum dimensions in the mandatory requirements are defined by the room itself and are to be verified on site. Bidder could propose alternate means for making the system fit within the confines of the requirements.

Q18. Could PSPC advise what is needed to be NFPA, or to do the systems with the 4" gaps?

A18. Please see comments above which resolve this question.
