Enquiries - Request for Standing Offers - Clause # 2.4

To ensure consistency and quality of information provided to Offerors, significant enquiries received and the replies to such enquiries will be provided simultaneously to Offerors to which the Request For Standing Offers has been sent, without revealing the sources of the enquiries.

Here are questions which we have received until now:

Question 1: Ref: Annex C and Appendix 1 of Annex C

If I understand correctly, according to section C.1.2 of Annex C: 4 hours of equipment and personnel must be included with the unit price, and if the schedule is overrun, the overtime will be charged in accordance with (IAW) Annex 1 - Table 6. Is that right?

Answer 1: Yes, this is correct. However, there is an error in Annex C, in both sections C.1.2 and C.2.2. Please replace the words "~~Part VI~~" and "~~Table 6~~" by "**Part VII**" and "**Table 7**". Below, the two paragraphs corrected in sections C.1.2 and C.2.2:

NOTE: The unit prices that you specify must include all costs related to the collection, transport and disposal of the materials. Thereby, no additional costs such as hourly rate*, travel expenses, environmental charges, different surcharges, etc. may be charged to CFB Bagotville for the collection of the materials listed in Table 1 of Appendix 1 of this Annex, except in the cases identified in **Part VII** of this Annex - Service calls.

* A maximum of four (4) hours will be allocated for each collection; all excess hours will be charged at the rates specified in **Table 7** of Appendix 1 of this Annex.

Question 2: Ref: Item # 6 of Table 1 and Item # 2 of Table 8 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

What is the concentration of your glycols? To be covered by the SOGHU, they need have a concentration of at least 25%.

Answer 2: Item # 6 of Table 1 refers to all other glycols not covered by SOGHU.
Item # 2 of table 8 refers to all antifreeze (glycol) covered by SOGHU.

Question 3: Ref: Item # 4 of Table 8 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

Do you have filters that are not covered by the SOGHU? Jet fuel or gas filters for example, because they are not in the table.

Answer 3: Yes, the filters that are not covered by the SOGHU, like filters for gas, jet propellant, etc... are disposed via the hydrocarbon-contaminated solids container (as well as towels, absorbing material, empty oil tubes, etc...).

Question 4: Ref: Item # 5 of Table 8 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

Aerosols must be placed in UN drums IAW Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations. Since they are stored in rolling bins, will they be transferred to drums by your employees before collection? Otherwise we will need to use time and space to siphon it.

Answer 4: Aerosols have always been picked up and transported in 360 L roll-out bins and will not be transferred to drums before transport. You are free to siphon them into your own drums if you like. There will be space available outside and in the warehouse.

Question 5: Ref: Item # 4 of Table 2 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

On Table 2 - Item 4, who is putting the contaminated soils in drums or Quatrex? Is it CFB Bagotville or the offeror? If it is the offeror, are those fees included in the unit price or are they charged IAW table 6?

Answer 5: Contaminated soils generally come from small spillage that are picked up by base employees and put in 205 L 1A2 drums or Quatrex bags. They will then be identified, tracked and weighted.

Question 6: Ref: Item # 7 of Table 1 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

What are the sizes and volumes of cylinders of item 7 of table 1?

Answer 6: Cylinders in which refrigerant gas and ODS are stored normally have a capacity of 30 lbs (13.6 kg), or more rarely a capacity of 50 lbs (22.7 kg).

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Question 7: Ref: Item # 21 of Table 1 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

On line 21 of table 1, the law forbids the transportation of transformers containing oil with PCB>50 PPM. Disposal will need to be done in 2 steps, the transformer alone (charged by kg) and the oil in drums (by liters). The disposal rate is done by kg at the only existing disposal site and not at the unit, as mentioned on line 21, because the transformers can have varying dimensions. How can we write down that rate by kg?

Answer 7: This item is removed from the request, please disregard this item in your offer.

Question 8: Ref: Item # 22 of Table 1 of Appendix 1 of Annex C

Concerning the disposal rate of oil containing PCB>50 ppm, there exists a rate for 50 to 500 ppm and a rate for 500+ ppm, which is double. Which rate would you like?

Answer 8: The rate for 50 to 500 ppm will be the one required for our needs.
