

Questions and Answers #1

Q1. Can you please clarify the extent of doors and frames to be finished as part of this scope of work? Will doors and frames only be finished if the adjacent wall surfaces are receiving new paint finishes? (ie. Would stairwell doors and frames be painted, both sides or on the corridor side only? Would the suite side of doors and frames in suite 125, for example, be painted? What about the associated bathroom door and frame?)

A1. The doors and frames will be painted on both sides in accommodation rooms (including bathroom), storage rooms, janitor rooms, and in stairwells and corridors.

Q2. If your intent is to paint the ceiling grid in the corridors, would you be allowing to remove all of the ceiling tiles prior to painting?

A2. Corridor ceilings are ceiling tiles and WILL NOT REQUIRE PAINTING.

Q3. Is it only the bathrooms in the suites that require drywall ceilings to be painted?

A3. The accommodation rooms are ceiling tile and will require the drywall ceiling in the bathroom to be painted.
