## Amendment 01

This amendment is being raised to publish Q&A and post a list of site visit attendees.

### A) Questions & Answers

Q1) What are the requirements for removal of construction waste?

R1) Refer to specifications Section 01 74 21 - Waste Management and Disposal

Q2) Will PCA provide temporary heat?

R2) Refer to specifications Section 01 51 00 - Temporary Utilities

Q3) What local permitting is required from PCA?

R3) PCA will acquire a building permit (issued by Parks Canada Agency Development office) as well as any electrical related permitting or inspections required for this project. Contractor is required to obtain any permitting or inspections specific to any work that is included to the scope of this contract such as gas fitting.

Q4) What is the closest water source for construction purposes?

R4) A potable water hose bib is available for free use located at the Trailer Side Shower Building, located approximately 1.5km driving distance from the work site.

Q5) Are there any restrictions on working hours or days?

R5) There are no restrictions on working hours or working days.

Q6) Please confirm if the supply and installation of the taps is by the GC or the owner?

R6) As per the drawings (washroom fixtures table, sheet 4), lavatory to be supplied and installed by owner. This includes faucets and shower heads/fixtures.

Q7) Is the GC or the owner to connect the shower bases?

R7) As per the drawings (washroom fixtures table, sheet 4), lavatory to be supplied and installed by contractor. This includes drainage hookups.

Q8) Are the shower taps and heads supplied and installed by the GC or the owner?

R8) As per the specifications (summary of work, page 2 of 3), plumbing fixtures are to be supplied and installed by owner. This includes shower taps and shower heads.

Q9) Please confirm if the East and West walls have tile on them?

R9) Yes, the east and west walls of the building are to be tiled. The tile specifications and layout will be the same as the male and female entry walls as shown in the drawings (sheet 9, combination of T2 and T3).

Q10) The "Washroom Fixture" schedule states WPT – Solid plastic partitions. The specifications 10 21 13 – 2.2.2 – reads... "Phenolic Toilet Partitions". The list of acceptable manufacturers is predominantly metal toilet partitions manufacturers. Can you please confirm the washroom partitions material; solid plastic, phenolic or metal?

R10) All water closet stall and shower stall partitions (WPT 1, WPT 2, WPT 3) are to be solid plastic as stated in the washroom fixture schedule within the drawings. The specifications will be updated to include this change.
