



	The Bidder must identify in their proposal the name of the resource that will act as a Contract Manager/Liaison Officer between the provider and Statistics Canada and administer the Contract on the part of the provider.

	A) The Bidder must demonstrate that they have contingency plans systems and / or procedures in place to allow contract obligations to be met in the event of disruption in the contractor's normal business operations. (Maximum ten (10) points) (Maximum one (1) page)	
	B) Identify the methods for auditing the quality and performance of the work. (Maximum ten (10) points) (Maximum one (1) pages)

	10 points = Demonstrated complete and full understanding of the requirement; clear recognition of problems and sound, even creative solutions;
