Responses to APN Questions:

Q1. "I was wondering whether the approach PSPC was intending to sign three separate contracts, one for each stream or were you expecting to sign one contract and consultants would build teams to deliver all 3 streams. Knowing your approach would help us get prepared and organized with building teams now as opposed to when the RFP is issued."

A1. Canada intends to issue only one contract with the Consultant who will need to build the necessary teams to deliver all three service streams.

Q2. "One other question that would be very good to know is what the approximate value of the contract would be. This would very much help in determining the size of the consulting team we would need to build"

A2. The total contract value including options exercised at the discretion of PSPC, is up to \$35 million (excluding taxes) over a period of up to 15 years.

Q3. "We are extremely interested in this program and would like to find out if PSPC intends to schedule an "Industry Engagement Session" in the near future and prior to the release of a formal RFP?"

A3. PSPC is considering some form of industry engagement following the posting of the RFP on Buy & Sell, subject to the level of interest from industry to the Request for Proposal.

Q4. "In addition, and in the spirit of forming a team of interested parties, how would you recommend that we obtain information regarding other companies who would be interested in pursuing a discussion with us, and possibly other potential partners."

Q5. Are all firms (lead and sub consultants) expected to be exclusive, or can firms be on multiple submitting team?





A5. It is anticipated that R1410T GI9 (2013-04-25) Limitation of Submissions, below, will be included in the Request for Proposal.

R1410T GI9 (2013-04-25) Limitation of submissions

1. A Proponent may not submit more than one proposal. This limitation also applies to the persons or entities in the case of a joint venture. If more than one proposal is received from a Proponent (or, in the case of a joint venture, from the persons or entities), all such proposals shall be rejected and no further consideration shall be given.
2. A joint venture is defined as an association of two or more parties which combine their money, property, knowledge, skills, time or other resources in a joint business enterprise agreeing to share the profits and the losses and each having some degree of control over the enterprise.
3. An arrangement whereby Canada contracts directly with a prime consultant who may retain sub-consultants or specialist consultants to perform portions of the services is not a joint venture arrangement. A sub-consultant or specialist consultant may, therefore, be proposed as part of the Consultant Team by more than one Proponent. The Proponent warrants that it has written permission from such sub-consultant or specialist consultant to propose their services in relation to the services to be performed.
4. Notwithstanding paragraph 3. above, in order to avoid any conflict of interest, or any perception of conflict of interest, a Proponent shall not include in its submission another Proponent as a member of its consultant team, as a sub-consultant or specialist consultant.
5. Any joint venture entered into for the provision of professional services or other services must be in full compliance with the requirements of any provincial or territorial law pertaining thereto in the Province or Territory in which the project is located.
