Revised ANNEX "A" - REQUIREMENT

1. **Title:** Drafting and Survey Equipment and Supplies

2. **Background**

The Canadian Forces School of Military Engineering (CFSME) Combat Engineers are required to possess and deploy with ruggedized survey capability to conduct construction task on operations across the spectrum of conflict. This capability will enable technological superiority by providing data to support advanced geospatial planning tools, flexibility by allowing joint operations with the Royal Canadian Air Force, and operational readiness across the spectrum of conflict by supporting tasks like the construction of vehicle bridges in response to domestic disasters, or an austere military camp bed down in support of combat operations.

3. **Objective**

- a. To identify the locations of projects with military grid reference system to an accuracy of 1 meter,
- b. To provide relative accuracy on site to a margin of 10 centimeters,
- c. Build around an Electronic Total Station to enable one person measuring,
- d. Multiple measuring systems from manual optical to GPS enabled means, and
- e. Compatible with DND baseline systems and multimedia.

4. **Combat Engineer Tasks to be achieved with this Capability**

- a. Control of cut and fill heights, best done with an Electronic Total Station,
- b. Route design and construction,
- c. Horizontal control of bridge approaches, rough grade (ISO accom construction) either through automatic optical or digital levels, and
- d. Survey and planning of military camps, protective works and support infrastructure.

5. **Deliverables**

- a. Two sets of equipment. Each set will include:
 - i. Electronic Total Station,
 - ii. Two GPS receivers, one for the base Station, one for the rover,
 - iii. Three handheld controllers for the total station and both GPSs, and
 - iv. Minimum ancillary equipment to support the equipment specified above
- b. Tablet to allow classroom instruction of the systems, with smart board compatibility.
- c. Software support and maintenance must be in accordance with Annex B.
- d. An itemized breakdown of all deliverables is provided at Annex B, Basis of Payment.

6. Constraints

- A. Deliverables must be compatible in form, fit, function and quality to Leica Geosystems products as identified at Annex B. In the event where the proposed item(s) is an equivalent product, suppliers **MUST** submit the following in accordance with SACC B3000T:
1. Products that are equivalent in form, fit, function and quality to the item(s) specified in the bid solicitation will be considered where the Bidder:
 - a. designates the brand name, model and/or part number of the substitute product;
 - b. states that the substitute product is fully interchangeable with the item specified;
 - c. provides complete specifications and descriptive literature for each substitute product;
 - d. provides compliance statements that include technical specifics showing the substitute product meets all mandatory performance criteria that are specified in the bid solicitation; and
 - e. clearly identifies those areas in the specifications and **descriptive literature that support the substitute product's compliance with any mandatory performance criteria.**
 2. Products offered as equivalent in form, fit, function and quality will not be considered if:
 - a. the bid fails to provide all the information requested to allow the Contracting Authority to fully evaluate the equivalency of each substitute product; or
 - b. the substitute product fails to meet or exceed the mandatory performance criteria specified in the bid solicitation for that item.
 3. In conducting its evaluation of the bids, Canada may, but will have no obligation to, request bidders offering a substitute product to demonstrate, at the sole cost of bidders, that the substitute product is equivalent to the item specified in the bid solicitation.
