This first (001) solicitation amendment is raised to answer questions from the Industry and include a modification To Annex C.

Annex C contains an error in Paragraph 3.2.3.1 of the Specification. The width for the Support webbing (used with the Strap Assembly) must be 50.8mm wide and not 25.4mm wide. All other webbing applications in this paragraph must be 25.4mm as indicated.

3.2.3.1 Webbing – Support, Ties, Bindings, Tabs and Window Assembly Binding. The webbing used for these applications must be Class I - Single Woven, in accordance with Specification D-80-001-151/SF-001. The webbing must be in accordance with the applicable Drawings as per para 2.1 of this Specification, with the exception of the width requirement, which must be 25.4 mm wide (1-inch).

3.2.3.1 Webbing – Support, Ties, Bindings, Tabs and Window Assembly Binding. The webbing used for these applications must be Class I - Single Woven, in accordance with Specification D-80-001-151/SF-001. The webbing must be in accordance with the applicable Drawings as per para 2.1 of this Specification, with the exception of the width requirement, which must be **50.8 mm** wide (1-inch).

Q1: To clarify with respect to the Webbing Test Reports, Annex B (3.1.1.3) says a test report for Class I and Class II, however in Annex C under the material requirements, there are different widths of the webbing. So do we need to provide a test report for each webbing noted under the material requirements (as per it's width) or do we only provide only two webbing test reports, one for each class (I and II) regardless of the width.

A1: Webbing Certificates of Compliance required at the Bid stage and Webbing Test Reports required at the Pre-Production stage are required for each webbing width and are itemized as follows:

Class I

1. 7mm wide (Button Loop)
2. 25.4mm wide (Ties, Binding, Tabs and Window Assembly Binding)
3. 50.8mm wide (Support Webbing for the Strap Assembly)

Class II

1. 50.8mm wide (Handle and Strap Assembly)

Webbing Certificates of Compliance are a Mandatory requirement at the Bid stage, but bidders may submit full testing reports with their bids, in lieu of Certificates of Compliance, provided the Test Reports demonstrate full compliance with the applicable criteria.

Q2: For our sample submission, due to the closing deadline; can we provide our sample in a colour other than CAG? perhaps black? These colors are available off the shelf in the appropriate specs. If successful with our bid, we would then provide a pre-production sample that would be in CAG which would adhere to the specs.

If the answer is no for the above question, then we would like to request a 4 week extension to the closing date, so we can have a fabric mill run the specific color (CAG) Polyester fabric with PU coating that matches the exact specs in the SOA.

A2: The Pre-Award sample must be constructed with the specified fabric. If a colour other than Canadian Average Green is used in the Pre-Award sample, a lab dip of Canadian Average Green on the specified fabric, as per the specification and as used in the Pre-Award sample submitted, must be submitted in order to demonstrate the bidder's capability to provide the fabric in the specified colour.

Q3: In the RFP it states the color of the fabric to be Canada Average Green (CAG), however I do not see any specific mention of a L A B, RGB or Pantone reference to define CAG.

A3: Colour acceptance will be based on visual matching against the Sealed Sample DSSPM 281-01 Colour, Canadian Average Green. For information purposes, to aid in dye formulation development, the CIE L*a*b* coordinates (measurement conditions: D65 illuminant, 10 degree observer) for Canadian Average Green are as follows:

L* = 26.88
a* = -3.27
b* = 16.26

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
