1.4 SECURITY SCREENING

- .1 All workers shall undergo security screening in order to be granted a security classification as required by the Correctional Service of Canada and Public Works and Government Services Canada.
- .2 Section 01 35 13 provides a detailed description of the procedures involved in the security screening.
- .3 At the start of work, a job-site special meeting will be held with institution representatives to define the instructions governing security and site operation in a correctional environment.

1.5 CODES

- .1 The specifications will require that the work and materials comply with the National Building Code of Canada (NBC) and all other applicable provincial or local codes. The strictest requirements shall apply in case of contradiction or discrepancy.
- .2 The work shall be performed in a manner that meets or exceeds the following requirements:
 - .1 Contract documents
 - .2 Specified standards and codes as well as other documents cited as references

1.6 REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- .1 A copy of the following documents shall be kept at the job site:
 - .1 Contract drawings
 - .2 Specifications
 - .3 Amendments
 - .4 Amended shop drawings
 - .5 Modification orders
 - .6 Other contract amendments

1.7 SUBSOIL STUDY

- .1 A soil test report is available for consultation and is attached to the specifications.

1.8 WORK SCHEDULE

- .1 The successful bidder shall initiate work immediately upon receiving notice that the contract has been awarded. The work covered by this document, including measures to correct construction deficiencies, must be completed within the schedule specified herein. Failure to comply with the schedule shall be dealt with as provided for in the Standard Acquisition Clauses and Conditions (SACC) Manual, Public Works and Government Services Canada (PWGSC).

- .2 Within 10 business days of contract award, submit a work schedule for the various project phases, the completion date of which will be no later than July 20, 2018. The work period is established at **10 weeks**.
- .3 Within 10 business days of contract award, submit shop drawings, technical data sheets, samples and security screening applications for approval.
- .4 The work sequence is as follows:
 - .1 Start-up meeting and schedule submission, shop drawings, technical data sheets, samples and security screening applications for approval
 - .2 Approval of documents submitted
 - .3 Construction start-up
 - .4 Phase 1: Expansion of the existing parking-lot;
 - .5 Phase 2: Improvements of the existing parking-lot;
 - .6 Submission of operating and maintenance manuals for approval;
 - .7 Provisional acceptance;
 - .8 Training of operating personnel;
 - .9 Correction of deficiencies; and
 - .10 Final approvals.
- .5 Within ten (10) business days of contract award, the Contractor shall provide, in a format acceptable to the Project Manager, a work schedule indicating:
 - .1 Dates for submitting shop drawings, lists of materials and samples;
 - .2 Delivery dates for the following pieces of equipment and materials;
 - .3 Start-up and completion dates for the work described in each section of the specifications; and
 - .4 Final completion date with respect to the completion date stipulated in the contract documents
- .6 Changes to milestones in the submitted schedule shall be at the discretion of the CSC Project Manager. The schedule shall be updated by the Contractor with the cooperation and approval of the CSC Project Manager.
- .7 If the proposed works are to be performed outside normal working hours: coordination is required with the CSC Project Manager.

The following shall form an integral part of the following tender documents:

***“Tender Documents and Drawings for La Macaza
Institution: Expansion of the parking facilities”***

1. Q : Can you confirm that the unit of items 5.3, 5.4, 5.5 and 5.6 are in cubic metres ? They are not in linear metres ?

A : The units of items 5.3, 5.4, 5.5 and 5.6 in the bid form are in linear meter. Refer to revised bid form attached to this document.

2. Q : During the site visit, we have discussed with the consultants and the institution representatives that the work period of 5 weeks would be revised. Any changes concerning the work period?

A : A work period of 10 weeks will be permitted. Refer to revised section 01 00 50 attached to this document.

3. Q : There is 2 different unit price schedule for the following sections : 1.0, 3.0, 4.0, 5.0, 7.0 and 8.0. Please provide clarifications. Items 5.5 and 5.6 of page 1/7 is the same article?

R : Refer to revised bid form for clarification, the article numbers have been modified and are now only appearing once. Items 5.5 and 5.6 of page 1/7, which are items 5.34 and 5.35 in the revised bid form, are two different articles. Item 5.34 is the supply of the lifting gate while item 5.35 is the installation of this one.

4. Q : Regarding article 5.31 in the bid form, is the gate control system an autonomous system or is it interconnected with the facility? Is it possible to request the type and or model number of the card readers for the parking pedestal?

A : The gate control system is an autonomous system, as shown on electrical plan 11/12, the card readers model must be HID R40 or approved equal.

5. Q : Following modification #8 which includes a bid form, did the contract go from lump sum to unit price? Are the quantities presented within appendix 4 part of the tender documents and used for the payments or are they for indication only?

A : The contract is lump sum. The quantities presented in appendix 4 are part of the tender documents but are indicative only, the payments will not be based on these quantities.

6. Q : I am having difficulties understanding the answer to the question concerning the security system. Is the question related to the motorised gate and its components? If so, Paradox does not fabricate motorised gates. Who is the supplier for the motorized gate?

A : The supplier of the motorized gate and its components can either be Automatic System, Pivin Drapeau or approved equal.

7. Q : Is it the general contractor or the electrician's responsibility to do the civil work related to the electrical work? More specifically the excavation, backfill of the electrical trench for duct banks, light post foundations, motorized gate foundation and pull boxes.

A : It is the responsibility of the general contractor to carry out all the work as well as the specialized resources in order to complete the work according to the plans and specifications.
