- Q1)** What is the work schedule? (day or night work)
- A1)** A Combination of day and night - any noisy, smelly work or hot work will be done during the off hours.
- Q2)** Does the project schedule account for a 6-8 week lead time on the millwork? (current average lead time)
- A2)** The millwork could be a deficiency provided after substantial completion
- Q3)** Is the work being done at the Vanier facility or a different location?
- A3)** 1200 Vanier
- Q4)** Are there any special procedures for arriving on site before every work shift that might result in any delays?
- A4)** Sign in at the loading dock where an escort will meet the contractors
- Q5)** Will there be any location for placing a waste bin on site during the work, or are contractors to remove all waste from site at the end of every shift?
- A5)** Yes, a site for a waste bin can be arranged
- Q6)** Are we required to use any base building service provider... Fire Alarm bypass, Controls, HVAC, Sprinklers and controls?
- A6)** Yes - any Hot work will have to be arranged thru BGIS
- Q7)** Our team has PSPC standard – Reliability and Secret clearances. Would that be acceptable for clearance requirement?
- A7)** We don't accept PSPC security. No, only RCMP security clearance is acceptable. Since security clearances are only issued after the award of a contract, bidders do not have to submit them during the bidding period.
