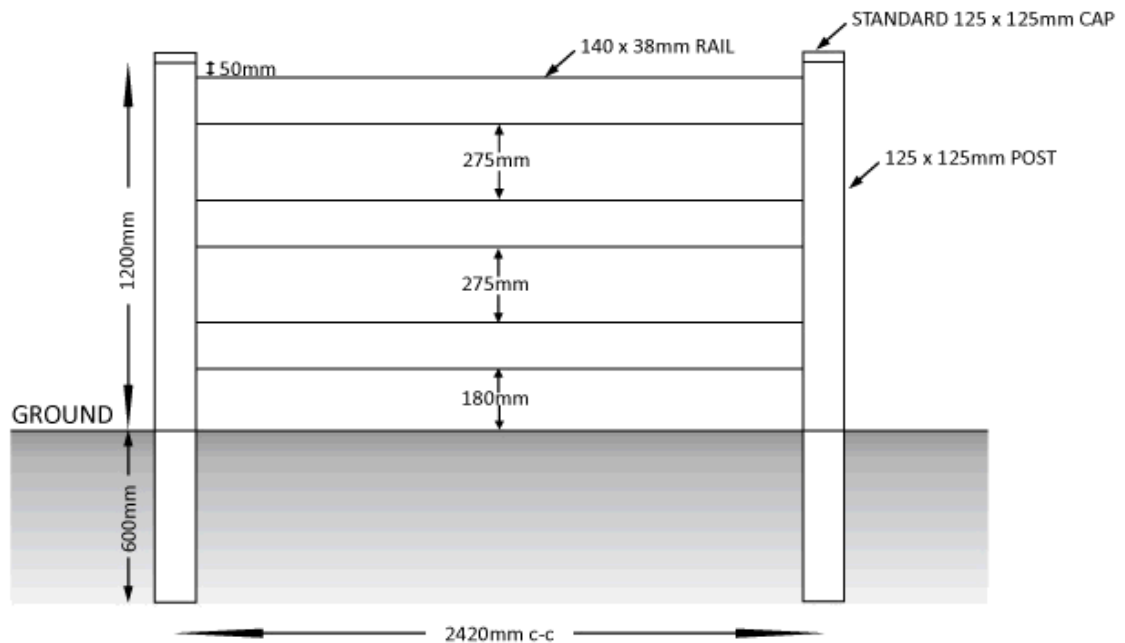
### B) Questions & Answers

- Q1. Note on drawing 011 reads "Slopes and any area not used for parking to be rehabilitated and landscaped using boulders and landscaping gravels" can you please provide more information on this? Size of boulders, spacing, and quantities? What type of "landscaping gravels" and at what point do we stop? (the use of "any area not used for parking" is not well defined). What is the payment terms for this scope?
- A1. This will be a field call as to the extent of work area. Boulders will only be used if they are present already on site. Landscaping gravel to be used between pavement shoulder and current disturbed footprint as per drawing 007.
- Q2. Your tender calls for "The Contractor must be responsible to provide and maintain coverage for Products/Completed Operations hazards on its Commercial General Liability insurance policy, for a period of six (6) years beyond the date of the Certificate of Substantial Performance." I have been informed by our insurance company this term is not available in Western Canada, the normal time frame is 24 months.
- A2. "The Contractor must be responsible to provide and maintain coverage for Products/Completed Operations hazards on its Commercial General Liability insurance policy, for a period of six (6) years beyond the date of the Certificate of Substantial Performance." The onus will be on the contractor to provide and maintain coverage for suitable insurance policy.
- Q3. Can we weld the floor beams and delete the bolted connection as per detail a on 006?
- A3. Bidders are recommended to bid as is according to specification. Requests will be reviewed prior to construction.
- Q4. Will concrete pumping over the river be permitted?
- A4. This will be determined via Environment Protection Plan. EPP will be required in order to meet obligations as per the BIA. It is the contractor's requirement to produce an EPP for approval by PCA prior to mobilization.
- Q5. Can details be provided for components within the parking lot and visitor amenity area such as; picnic tables, pedestrian bollards, new restroom, wooden fence, and information sign?
- A5. Shrubs/Trees - The area and density will be best described post bridge erection as this will undoubtedly disturb the ground. Works related to Shrubbery and trees will be addressed in a form of a change order once we have a precise feel for the scope of rehabilitation required. Bidders are to bid accordingly and not include shrubbery and tree work as part of the bid.

Toilet Spec - The info in the current spec provides enough information to provide an even platform for bid pricing. If we choose to go with a more elaborate design post bid award, the change in scope will be addressed in a form of a change order.

- Q6. Note #3 on Drawing #4 indicates that the weld metal is to be tested to this Charpy V-notch test. I have discussed this with our certified fabricator companies and they have never seen this requirement.  
How can this be tested once the weld has been made?
- A6. Industry standard is that Charpy testing results for weld metal are typically provided by the electrode suppliers.
