Amendment 001

This Amendment 001 is being raised to answer questions raised, change the closing date and to revise the Solicitation.

I. QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q1: We note that some of the areas of work could require legal services. Is this procurement intended to apply to law firms, or will there be a separate procurement for a legal advisors VOR?

A1: Legal services are not to be included as part of this requirement. There will not be a separate procurement for legal advisors.

Q2: Is the security requirement one that must be in place at the time of submission, or is an application in progress sufficient?

A2: As per the RFSO section 6.1, Security Requirements, the security clearance must be obtained before issuance of the Standing Offer, not at bid closing.

Q3: With respect to the requirement to have resources available in major business centres (Vancouver, Ottawa, Toronto, Montreal), is a willingness to travel sufficient or must the successful proponent have offices in those cities?

A3: As this is a National Master Standing Offer, proposed resources must be located in at least two regions, Pacific and National Capital. Contractor travel may be necessary and will require prior approval by the RFSO and RFSA Project Authority and be subject to the TBS Directive on Travel, Hospitality, Conference and Event Expenditures. As stipulated in Annex B – Basis of Payment: All travel must have the prior authorization of the Project Authority. These expenses will be paid upon submission of an itemized statement supported by receipt vouchers.

Q4: Are joint submissions (e.g. with a financial advisory firm) allowed?

A4: Submissions from joint ventures are allowed as per the conditions set under Standard Instructions 2006, section 17 added as a reference in the RFSO. Call-up against the Standing Offer will only be issued to the Joint Venture and not its individual parties. Bidders may not submit multiple Offers in response to the RFSO.

Q5: For the projects contained in the resource profiles can PWGSC confirm that it is acceptable that the "criteria/duties" stated in the table on Page 43 of 63 are met by collectively demonstrating the experience across the combination of projects (2 or 4 projects depending on level) rather than demonstrating all the required work activities in each project?

A5: Bidders must demonstrate the required experience across the combination of projects provided. Demonstrating all work activities in each project is not required. Bidders are encouraged to provide projects that showcase multiple work activities.

Q6: Does accepting a SO preclude the Offeror's firm from working in detailed design, construction, engineering or other phases/services of that specific project?

A6: The Work that is issued through a Call-up may cause a conflict of interest. Any potential conflict will be addressed in the Call-up at the time of issuance.

II. REVISIONS

In the original solicitation, on page 4 of 63, we stated, "Offerors that submit a response to the RFSO do not have to submit a response to the RFSA." We are amending the solicitation to delete the preceding sentence and ask that Bidders submit a separate response for the RFSO and the RFSA.

4. On Page 15 of 63, **DELETE** article 7A.7 in its entirety. **INSERT** the following:
7A.7.1 The Identified Users authorized to make call-ups against the Standing Offer include any government department, agency or Crown corporation listed in Schedules I, I.1, II, III, of the Financial Administration Act, R.S., 1985, c. F-11.
7A.7.2 The Identified Users are required to contact the Project Authority. The Project Authority's role will be to assist Identified Users determine which Offeror is next on the call-up rotation, help define the requirement and offer general guidance.
7A.7.3 The Identified Users are required to complete the Contractor Performance Assessment as per article A.15.
5. On Page 18 of 63, article 7A.15 Performance Assessment, **DELETE:**
 1. Offerors must take note that the performance of the Offeror upon completion of the services will be evaluated by Canada. The evaluation includes the following criteria:

 - i quality (This is for the rating of the quality of not only the final deliverable but also the deliverables throughout the various stages of the project.);
 - ii time (This is the rating of time planning and schedule control.);
 - iii project management (This is the rating of how the project was managed including the project delivery, and overall consultant services.); and
 - iv contract management (This is the rating of quality of cost planning and control during the life of the project.)

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
