



AMENDMENT #2

The purpose of this amendment is to share answers following questions asked by potential bidders.

You must consider the information in the evaluation of your bid.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Q1.

Do we have the right to insert photos in Appendices E, F and H?

A1.

No, photos can only be included in Appendix G.

Q2.

a) Regarding the organization chart, should we use the same format as the one on your form?

b) If we have to, should we enter something in the boxes beginning with an X (ex: X. Production Team Architecture)?

c) In your form, where should we insert the chart, on page 4 or 6?

A2. a)

A2. b)

a) No, organization chart in the documents is an example for illustrative purposes only.

A2. c)

In Part 2 of the proponent identification form (Appendix E), to replace the example with your organization chart.

Q3.

In 3.2.3 - 10, it is mentioned that the proponent must insert four photos for each of the nine projects presented under criterion 2. For projects 6 and 7, the projects of the mechanical engineer and the engineering engineer electrical engineering, would it be possible not to submit photos? For these two disciplines, it is customary to take photographs of readings before the start of work only. The survey photos would in fact be useless for Parks Canada without the photos in the pipeline and the photos once the project is completed. Is it possible not to submit photos for these two projects?

A3. In Appendix F, for PROJECTS 6 and 7, the proponent, if it wishes, may provide only two (2) photos instead of four (4) photos as required. At least one (1) of the photos must show a general view of the building where the intervention took place. The other photo will be the choice of the proposer.

Q4.

On page 26 of the Request for Proposal you mention that the original and copies must be stapled. Would bidding the proposal be acceptable as the document is too bulky to be stapled?

A4.

Proponents may choose to submit the proposal according to the solid fastening system of their choice such as staples, binding comb or T-Pins. The only condition is that the sheets forming the proposal does not come apart (paper clip or binder clips will not be accepted).



There is no change to the bid closing date.
