QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Question 7	 What is meant to be included in the hourly rate and what is meant to be reimbursed on a case by case basis? For the mortuary part (M1 and M2), we are asked to provide an hourly rate. Does this exclude products and services like: Maple casket Airfare for the repatriation (it could greatly vary depending on the location of the remains). Hermetic sealer for the remains Hearse for the funerals Renting of equipment needed for the work abroad.
Answer 7	The Firm All-Inclusive Hourly Rate includes all professional fees. Non- professional fees are to be included in "Other Direct Expenses," as per B.3.2 of the Basis of Payment in "Annex B," to be reimbursed upon submission of an itemized statement supported by receipt vouchers. The hourly rate should only factor in the <u>time</u> it takes the contractor to, for example, coordinate the casket's manufacture, and to arrange for the shipment of the casket. Therefore, the fees for the maple caskets, hearse for the funerals, renting of equipment, and shipping should not be included in the hourly rate. There will not be any "airfare for the repatriation," because remains will not be repatriated to Canada. The remains are buried in the closest appropriate cemetery to where they fell. This has been stated in paragraph 4.5 of the Statement of Work (SOW) in the Request For Proposal (RFP), which says, "on 15 July 1970, an Order in Council outlined that remains of Canada's war dead preceding 1970, continue to observe the previous policy not to be repatriated." It is extremely unlikely that "hermetic sealer for the remains," will be required.

Question 8	What needs to be included for the funerals apart from the Casket and Hearse?	
Answer 8	Typically, the casket, the coach, and wreaths.	
Question 9	Are Pallbearers needed or would the army provide them?	
Answer 9	No. Pallbearers are not needed, as it will be provided by the Canadian Army, or	
	the Royal Canadian Air Force.
