- Clearly articulate the roles and responsibilities of the IAMC-TMX Senior Science Advisor in relation to the Committee (2 points);
- Demonstrate a leadership style that aligns with the IAMC goal and guiding principles (6 points).

Understanding of UNDRIP, TRC and Aboriginal and Treaty Rights (12 pts);

- Clearly articulate the relationship between the goal and guiding principles of the IAMC and principles of UNDRIP, TRC and Aboriginal and Treaty Rights (6 points);
- Clearly articulates commonalities and differences among the perspectives held by Indigenous groups and government on UNDRIP, TRC and Aboriginal and Treaty Rights (6 points);

Understanding of Traditional Ecological Knowledge (12 pts);

- Clearly articulates the value of Traditional Ecological Knowledge (4 points);
- Clearly articulates challenges of working with Traditional Ecological Knowledge (4 points);
- Clearly articulate their experience bringing together Traditional Ecological Knowledge and western science (4 points).
