### **SOLICITATION AMENDMENT 003**

This solicitation amendment is raised to :

#### **1. Provide answers to bidders questions in relation to the solicitation**

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**Q.1 We have the following questions regarding M1, which states, “The proposed resource must have successfully completed a college diploma or university undergraduate degree in engineering or science from a Canadian College, University or equivalent from a foreign institution, as determined by the World Education Services <http://www.wes.org/ca>.”**

- 1. Do resources who graduated from American universities need to go through this process?**
- 2. The WES services indicates a 20 business day turn around for Educational Credential Assessments. We have identified qualified candidates with foreign education, however there isn't time for the Assessment to be completed by bid submission. Will DRDC accept bids with resources whose Assessments are in process, provided they are awarded prior to completion of the Bid evaluation?**

A.1.1 Yes, all resources with education from outside Canada must go through this process.

A.1.2 Canada cannot confirm or deny the timelines indicated for credential assessment. The subject clause is a standard clause used in most TBIPS requirements as well as other similar professional services requirements. Given the importance education plays in the role of this commodity, and since it plays heavily in the validation of the qualification requirements of individual resources, it is imperative that Canada evaluate this education. Deferring this process to Contract award would not meet Canada's objectives. Canada will not change this requirement as requested. However, to give Bidders more time to complete the assessment by bid closing, Canada has extended the RFP closing date by one week.
