## QUESTION AND ANSWER #1

### Question #1

“If your device is selected for laboratory testing, how quickly could the device be sent to the laboratory to be tested?”

Are you looking for a time frame of how long it takes for you to be able to send to your own laboratory for testing?

### Answer #1

Once a device passes a review by the Drugs and Driving Committee (DDC) of the Canadian Society of Forensic Science under section 3 of the Oral Fluid Standards and Evaluation Procedures, the DDC notifies the manufacturer that the device is now approved to go to a federal laboratory to be physically tested against the other standards set out in their Oral Fluid Standards and Evaluation Procedures. The question is asking manufactures what the time frame would be between being notified of that decision and having the device shipped for laboratory testing.

### Question #2

Does this RFI include cannabis supply contracts?

### Answer #2
