# AMENDMENT #3

Questions and Answers 5-7:

Q5. On drawing D-S9 there's a note on the left side that says 42 treads 1170 wide and 6 treads 2690 wide; the long treads are the bottom run, so the 42 treads would mean 7 runs of 6 treads each. That's 8 runs, and 48 treads. If the long treads are being replaced with double-short treads that equates to 54 new treads.

The note on the picture of the tower says 6 runs total. That would mean 6 long treads and 30 short treads, therefore 42 new treads (long being replaced with double-short).

Looking at pictures of the tower online, its not perfectly clear, but it looks like there is definitely the single run of long treads at the bottom, and then 6 runs to the top. That would equate to 48 new treads (long being replaced with double-short).

Can you please confirm the existing short tread quantity.

A5. To clarify the stair tread requirements:

•There are a total of 7 runs of stairs. The bottom of these runs is currently 2690 wide (6 treads). The upper 6 runs are 1170 wide. (36 treads)

•The new design splits the bottom run into two with a new stringer down the middle and will require 12 new treads each approx. 1368mm +/- wide.

•The six runs above each have 6 treads approx. 1170mm +/- wide and will require 36 treads.

Note that the note on the photograph on D-S9 refers to 6 runs requiring new handrail which should read a total of 7 runs including the bottom run of stairs that require new handrail (all the runs require new handrail).

Q6. Can any work be done on the weekends?

A6. Yes, work can be done on the weekends from sunrise to sunset. Work outside of those hours on weekdays, weekends and/or holidays is also acceptable with prior approval.

# AMENDMENT #3 cont.

Q7. We are getting a lot of questions regarding access to the boardwalk from the marsh land for installation of the helical piles, as well as installation of the steel support structure, etc. Can you clarify in more detail exactly what would be allowed for us to use for access (barge, etc.)?

A7. All work must be done off of the existing boardwalk structure. A 2m buffer on either side of the existing boardwalk has now been trimmed to approximate boardwalk height. The trimmed floating vegetation mat on either side of the boardwalk can support the weight of pedestrian traffic to some extent, but not equipment. There is virtually no water access to the edge of the boardwalk section we are working on, therefore utilisation of a barge or boat is impossible.
