This amendment is being raised to distribute question and answers and to make changes to the special instructions.

A) QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q2 For the ESC plan developed by the Departmental representative is it possible to provide typical expected ESC controls for the constructions items. IE culverts, ditching, widening, etc.

A2 In addition to following the included referenced Parks Canada National Best Management Practices, typical erosion and sediment control plan measures would include:

- silt fence when grading around water bodies
- slope tracking and/or erosion control blanket after seeding on all disturbed areas of ditch/side slope
- sediment control logs or wattles, straw bales and/or geotextile soil stabilization on steep ditches where water flow is concentrated

Should any highly specialized erosion control materials be requested by the Departmental Representative, the materials would be paid for under 01 21 00 Allowances.

Q3 Under Survey Requirements "The Department Representative will provide all surveying required to complete the work identified in the Contract documents." Does this include all layout and will control/survey files be provided for any machine control. Also does this include setting elevations for culverts and as-building of all quantity related work?

A3 Yes, the Departmental Representative will provide all on-site surveying including setting culverts and quantity pick-up. Control monuments and machine control files can be provided for the ditch excavation.

Q4 For pages 24 through 26 on document itt_18-0020_b could a sample calculation be provided?
