DELETE:

The Contractor hereby offers to perform the services commencing upon contract award to **December 31, 2018**.

INSERT:

The Contractor hereby offers to perform the services commencing upon contract award to **March 31, 2019**.

Annex B – Terms of Reference, Section 8 – Language Requirement

DELETE:

All **deliverables** to be provided in English.

INSERT:

All **draft documents** to be provided in English. **The final report must be provided in both official languages English and French.**

Mandatory criteria M1

DELETE:

The Bidder must demonstrate that the **proposed resource(s)** has a minimum ten (10) or more years of experience within the past fifteen (15) years, **in marine oil spill and/or HNS release risk assessment *projects in a Federal/Provincial and/or Territorial Government departments organizations (including crown corporations, agencies and non-government stakeholders defined as Indigenous groups, communities, industry and the general public)**

Projects are defined as:

- at least \$50,000 per project **and having a duration of not less than 6 months.**
- **the** probability and potential impacts/consequences of marine oil spill and/or HNS release were evaluated. The bidder must provide a description of each project that illustrates how they meet this criteria.

INSERT:

The Bidder must demonstrate that the proposed resource(s) has a minimum ten (10) or more years of experience within the past fifteen (15) years, **conducting** marine oil spill and/or HNS release risk assessment *projects.

Projects are defined as:

- at least \$50,000 per project **in the last ten (10) years.**

- **Projects where** the probability and potential impacts/consequences of marine oil spill and/or HNS release were evaluated. The bidder must provide a description of each project that illustrates how they meet this criteria.

If the Bidder is using a proposed resource to meet this criteria they must provide the resources' resume.

Mandatory Criteria M3

DELETE:

The Bidder must demonstrate that the company or proposed resources have combined to complete a minimum of four (4) marine oil spill and/or HNS release risk assessment projects, where they presented the risk assessment framework and/or risk results **in a Federal/Provincial and/or Territorial Government departments organizations (including crown corporations, agencies and non-government stakeholders defined as Indigenous groups, communities, industry and the general public)**

Projects are defined as:

- at least \$50,000 per project **and having a duration of not less than 6 months.**
- Projects where the probability and potential impacts/consequences of potential marine oil spill and/or HNS releases were evaluated. The bidder must provide a description of each project that clearly illustrates how they meet this criteria.

INSERT:

The Bidder must demonstrate that the company or proposed resources have **(combined projects)** to complete a minimum of four (4) marine oil spill and/or HNS release risk assessment projects, where they presented the risk assessment framework and/or risk **assessment results to government and non-government stakeholders.**

Government Stakeholders are defined as: Federal/Provincial, municipal officials.

Non-government stakeholders are defined as: Indigenous groups, communities, industry and the general public.

Projects are defined as:

- at least \$50,000 per project **in the last ten (10) years.**
- Projects where the probability and potential impacts/consequences of potential marine oil spill and/or HNS releases were evaluated. The bidder must provide a description of each project that clearly illustrates how they meet this criteria.

If the Bidder is using a proposed resource to meet this criteria they must provide the resources' resume.

This amendment shall form part of the agreement. All other terms and conditions of the said agreement shall remain unchanged and in force.
