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**This solicitation amendment is raised in order to answer received questions.**

**Question 1:**

I would like to know if the business number is sufficient as a provincial business license.

**Answer 1:**

Yes.

**Question 2:**

Au Québec comme il y a la CNESST nous ne sommes pas obligés d'avoir un plan de santé et sécurité.

Est-ce que le numéro d'inscription à la CNESST peut être suffisant?

**Answer 2:**

Please see Amendment 001 to the RFSA. The Health and Safety plan is no longer a mandatory requirement.

**Question 3:**

P.1 of 51: In this RFSA, should we assume that a valid security clearance from CISC is required to bid? Or should we assume that in the event that we are selected as a supplier under this RFSA, we will have to undertake this process before the arrangement (contract) is formally signed?

**Answer 3:**

Security is not required to bid. It is also not required in order to be awarded an arrangement.

Most work associated with this requirement will have no security requirements, but they could happen from time to time.

If work arises that has security requirements, only firms that have the appropriate level of security would be invited to bid.

If firms would like to be sponsored for security clearance they can do so at any time.

**Question 4:**

Part 3: It is mentioned in section 3.1 that the arrangements must be prepared in paper form and that electronic or fax transmissions will not be accepted. However, it also mentions that in case of incompatibility between the electronic version and the paper version, it is the paper version that prevails. Finally, in the tables describing the Mandatory Criteria, it is mentioned that the electronic copy must be produced in .pdf format. We would like to know if an electronic version should be submitted or not? If so, how should it be transmitted? If no, should we assume that the documents to be produced for Mandatory criteria should only be submitted in paper format?

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**Answer 4:**

We are requesting hard copies.

The directives in the tables regarding electronic copies is to be removed.

**Question 5:**

In the event that we wish to qualify for several streams of work, do we have to submit a document containing sections 1 to 3 (Technical Arrangement, Financial Arrangement and Certifications) individually for each of the streams of work?

**Answer 5:**

No, you can submit a technical arrangement with all the work streams you want to qualify in one document. However, we need four copies of that document.

We will ask you to clearly indicate in your submission which stream(s) of work you want to qualify for.

**Question 6:**

The technical arrangement contains only mandatory technical criteria and there are no point rated technical criteria (Bidder's expertise, experience of team members, work plan, methodology, etc.). Can you confirm that our understanding is in line with your expectations?

**Answer 6:**

Confirmed. There is no point rated criteria.

**Question 7:**

Section 4.1.1.1.7 (Work Streams 6): In the Mandatory Criteria Chart, at MTC 3, it is noted that suppliers with commission / license OLS, QLS or CLS are not required to provide information for MT3 for this stream. Does this mean that a supplier who holds an OLS, QLS or CLS license is not required to submit a copy of the deliverables for MT3?

**Answer 7:**

Confirmed. A supplier who holds a license OLS, QLS or CLS does not need to submit deliverables for MT3 in work stream 6.
