REVISION 002

This Revision answers questions from proponents and makes changes to the solicitation documents.

A. Questions & Answers

- Q2.** The RFP outlines a detailed list of Required Services in section 3 of the RFP, however, the projects and personnel requested to be submitted for this RFP in sections SRE 3.2.3 and 3.2.4 are only focused on RS1 Environmental Site Assessments, Risk Assessments and Site Remediation/Risk Management Measures. Will additional qualified personnel be required for this work, such as an Environmental Auditor or Certified Industrial Hygienist?
- A2.** Environmental Specialists can perform most of the tasks required in the RFSO, including management of contaminated sites and petroleum storage tank systems projects. For hazardous materials surveys, auditing, assessment and abatement, this would require a specialist in industrial hygiene or occupational health and safety. Environmental auditors would also be an additional qualified personnel to add.
- Q3.** Can Parks Canada provide any insight into how the total SOA value will be distributed by the Required Services?
- A3.** PCA estimates that 66% will be aimed at providing services to contaminated sites projects (i.e. Phase I, II, III Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs), Remedial Action Plans including Remediation Options Analysis, Risk Management Plans and Liability Cost Estimates, Human Health and Ecological Risk Assessments, Design and Tender Documents related to remediation of contaminated sites).

The remaining 33% is for other environmental services (i.e. Hazardous Materials/Waste Auditing and Abatement Monitoring, Mould Assessment and Abatement Monitoring, Petroleum and Allied Petroleum Storage Tank Systems Auditing, Environmental Auditing which may include provision of advice and/or training. Design and Tender Documents related to projects involving Petroleum and Allied Petroleum storage tanks).

- Q4.** For the separate regional proposals, will projects in the specific region score higher than those in a different region?
- A4.** If you are referring to proponents providing descriptions of significant projects for the evaluation of their proposal, no, projects would not score differently depending on the specific region of the project.
- Q5.** For the separate regional proposals, will personnel residing in the specific region score higher than those in a different region?
- A5.** See Appendix F SRE 3.2.2: the team's location for the delivery of the required services is part of the evaluation of the Team Approach / Management of Services, but this is only one component of the evaluation. Individual team members' residence location is not evaluated.
- Q6.** Will the successful consultant be required to provide all the RS services? Or can a consultant submit a proposal based on the assumption that they can provide (and state in this in the proposal) certain RS services i.e. Phase II & III but not Human Health and ecological risk assessment (HHERA)?
- A6.** Proponents are required to provide all services identified in Part 5 Standing Offer Brief – Required Services (RS). Proponents can partner or subcontract in order to provide all services.
