Unfortunately I am not able to send you an example report as PPSC has never used the Acquisitions module of the Justice Canada library system; the departments are responsible for maintaining separate budgets for library procurement.</p> <p>Presently, I use a combination of excel spreadsheets and data I request from Finance to track and manage procurement. What I would like to do is export data from the proposed system by Purchase Order number, Commitment number, region and vendor (fund and cost centre are the same for all library procurement) for each fiscal year. There is normally a short overlap period in April when new commitments are in place and the previous year's commitments are still active.</p>
