

Amendment 004 is issued to make the following changes to warranty provisions and the basis of selection, as well as, increasing the overall number of Rifle Plates to the totals below.

In Part 6B:

6.12 Product Warranty – The Plates must be warranted by the Manufacturer to provide the stated level of ballistic protection and must be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of five (5) years from the date of receipt by the RCMP.

The following clause is to be inserted at issuance of Standing Offer, if applicable:

In addition, the plates are warranted by the Manufacturer to provide the stated level of ballistic protection and must be free from defects in materials and workmanship for an period of ___ (to be inserted at issuance of Standing Offer) years over and above the minimum 5 years from the date of receipt by the RCMP. The total warranty period is ___ (to be inserted at issuance of Standing Offer) years (minimum warranty of 5 years plus the additional warranty).

Basis of Selection -

To be declared responsive, an offer must:

- a. comply with all the requirements of the Request for Standing Offers; and
- b. meet all mandatory technical evaluation criteria.

Offers not meeting (a) or (b) will be declared non-responsive.

The responsive offer with the lowest Price per Year of Warranty will be recommended for issuance of a Standing Offer.

The Warranty Period must be a minimum of 5 years from the date of receipt by the RCMP to a maximum of 10 years. The Offeror’s Average Firm Unit Price for all items, including extension periods (Annex A, A.3.) divided by the Offeror’s Warranty Period (in years) will determine the Offeror’s Price per Year of Warranty (rounded to 2 decimals).

Example:

	Average Firm Unit Price for Annex A, A.3. [Item 1 (Est. Qty x Firm Unit Price) + Item 2 (Est. Qty x Firm Unit Price) + Item 3 (Est. Qty x Firm Unit Price) / Total Quantity]	Warranty Period (in years)	Price per Year of Warranty (rounded to 2 decimals)
Offeror A	$(500 \times \$100) + (500 \times \$125) + (1000 \times \$150) / 2000 = \131.25	10	13.13
Offeror B	$(500 \times \$75) + (500 \times \$80) + (1000 \times \$100) / 2000 = \88.75	5	17.75

Offeror C	$(500 \times \$90) + (500 \times \$95) + (1000 \times \$100) / 2000 = \96.25	8	12.03
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In this example, Offeror C has the lowest Price per Year of Warranty.

In the event there is more than one offer with the identical lowest Price per Year of Warranty, the determination of the successful offeror will be made using the following factors. Each factor will be evaluated one at a time and in the order presented below until a single offer remains.

- a) The offer with the longest warranty period; followed by
- b) The offer with the lowest average weight per plate; followed by
- c) The offer with the smallest average thickness per plate.
