

Michipicoten Island, Lake Superior, Ontario –Lead-Based Paint and Associated Asbestos Abatement and Debris Removal

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MANDATORY ON-SITE BIDDERS MEETING

A Mandatory On-Site Bidders Meeting will be held on **June 12, 2018**. Attendance will be limited to one representative from each Bidder. Confirmation of attendance is required by **June 8, 2018 at noon**.

Meeting Time:

An on-Site meeting will be held on Michipicoten Island. Bidders will be provided return transportation from Wawa Municipal Airport to Michipicoten Island and back.

Meeting time prior to departure to the island will be on **June 12, 2018 at 10:00 am** at the Wawa Municipal airport.

Transit to Michipicoten Island will be by helicopter. The Helicopter will arrive at Wawa Municipal airport at approximately 10:00 am and will transport up to six passengers to the island. Depending on Bidders confirmation of attendance and intention to bid, additional flights will be arranged as necessary.

It is expected that the return flight from the island to Wawa Municipal airport will arrive around 15:30.

One representative from each company will be provided transportation to the Island.

Meeting location in Wawa:

All Bidders to meet at the Wawa Municipal Airport
Hwy 101, Wawa, P0S 1K0

Bidders are responsible for transportation to and from the meeting location including all associated arrangements and costs. The Wawa Municipal Airport is approximately 230 km (~3 to 3.5 hr drive time) from Sault Ste. Marie.

Driving Directions:

From Trans Canada Hwy, turn east at Hwy 101.
Travel along Hwy 101 approximately 45m;
Enter Wawa Municipal Airport (Google maps will navigate to 68 Mission Road).



Shuttle Service from Mainland will be Provided to Michipicoten Island and Return:

WiskAir Helicopters will provide transportation to and from Michipicoten Island.

Aircraft: 407 Bell

The Bell 407's cabin seats up to 6 passengers in wide-open, club-passenger seating.

Schedule:

The flight to Michipicoten Island is scheduled to depart at 10:15 and will be approximately 30 minutes (one way).

The Bidders meeting will be up to a maximum of 4 hours onsite once all Bidders have arrived on-Site.

Clothing / Equipment Required & Accessibility:

All people should be prepared for foul weather and pests on the island. This includes warm clothing, rain gear, sunscreen, insect repellent, etc.

Minimum PPE requirements include: high visibility vest, hard hat, safety glasses, CSA approved steel toed safety boots and work gloves.

Since space in the aircraft is limited no additional equipment, backpacks or bulky items will be permitted. Notebooks, a small camera and personal items able to be kept on person's lap during transit will be permitted.

The Site is not seasonally maintained and comprises uneven terrain, slopes, and stairs or steps. The Site does not generally include accessibility features.

Provision for Delay:

In the event of delay for reasons beyond PSPCs control (e.g. inclement weather, flight delay, etc.), the meeting time will be postponed as needed. In the event of delay beyond June 12, 2018, Bidders will be required to remain available for the meeting to occur on June 13, 2018 at the same times as planned. Accommodation arrangements in this situation will be the responsibility of Bidders and at the Bidders' cost.

Should further delays be experienced or it will be clear that the meeting will not be possible to be held on June 13, 2018 the meeting will be cancelled and the mandatory requirement will be waived.
