Amendment No. 001 is raised to address the following bidder question:

Q1: *"... In BC the first aid training regulations for forestry based crews is for Industrial and not wilderness first aid training as per Worksafe BC.*

Both CIFFC and BC Gov have accepted the Industrial first aid training, and or ambulance attendant training we have through Worksafe BC. Would the parks Canada Agency accept the same level of first aid per crew that BC recognizes, and if not would there be potential to show we have the required number of personnel registered into a wilderness course, and that it will be complete prior to SO award?"

Under Annex A – Statement of Work, Appendix A1 – Fireline Qualification for Wildland Firefighting Crews, specifically section 4. (f), delete and replace it with the following:
