Amendment 04

This amendment is being raised to extend the solicitation closing date, answer questions and make changes to the tender package.

A) Closing Date

The closing date for tender 5P420-18-0079A, titled *Virginia Falls Dock Replacement Design-Build - Nahanni National Park Reserve*, is extended from June 19, 2018 until June 21, 2018 at 2:00PM Mountain Daylight Time (MDT).

B) Question and Answers

Q16. Will Parks Canada be responsible removing and disposing the existing docks?

A16. Yes Parks Canada will be responsible for removing and disposing of the existing docks.

Q17. Please confirm if NNPR is responsible for providing the contractor with campsites, food, and a cook as stated in the Terms of Reference. The Summary of Work in the specifications indicate it is the contractor's responsibility.

A17. The Contractor will camp at the Virginia Falls Camp Ground, this consist of several camp sites of various sizes with tent platforms, fire pits and picnic tables. The contractor will be assigned suitable camp site(s) for their crew. The campground has a large bear proof storage locker that the contractors staff will use to store food and other bear attractants. The toilet facilities are outhouses and there is a shower facility for Park Staff that will be made available to the contractor staff as well. This shower uses a hanging solar bag system the contractor should provide their own means to heat shower water. If the contractor prefers to set up their own washing facilities a site will be designated by PCA, the contractors staff should use biodegradable soaps and follow the principles of no trace camping. A cook and food will be provided by PCA. There is no running water on site, all water comes from the Nahanni River and water is filtered for drinking.

Q18. Can Parks Canada or NNPR provide the contractor with electricity, fuel (diesel and gasoline), or potable water?

A18. Contractor responsible for generator and fuel for any electricity needs. Any fuel needs are the responsibility of the contractor. Parks Canada will provide potable water.

Q19. Generally a gangway of this length would require the integrated top railing to help support the 40 ft. length. We are making it in 3 sections so it can be transported to site, so the top railing would also help in joining the sections. We must also keep in mind this 40 ft gangway/ramp will be taking most of the lateral loading to stronger is better. Also it is usually a code requirement to have a railing on a gangway / ramp if it a certain distance from the ground. It is also a code for a gangway/ ramp to be all inclusive meaning acceptable for wheel chair access.

A19. There are several operational considerations for this site that inform the design. The risk of people falling off the ramp needs to be balanced against the risk of the Twin Otter wings contacting the ramp railings in low water resulting in damage to plane, the railing and putting plane passengers at risk. The current ramps do not have railings for this reason. This is a remote backcountry site that is not suitable for wheelchairs, the gangway/ramp need not meet accessibility code.

C) TENDER PACKAGE CHANGES

1. In the Terms of Reference, PD 2.7 section 1.A.

Add:

The Contractor will camp at the Virginia Falls Camp Ground, this consist of several camp sites of various sizes with tent platforms, fire pits and picnic tables. The contractor will be assigned suitable camp site(s) for their crew. The campground has a large bear proof

storage locker that the contractors staff will use to store food and other bear attractants. The toilet facilities are outhouses and there is a shower facility for Park Staff that will be made available to the contractor staff as well. This shower uses a hanging solar bag system the contractor should provide their own means to heat shower water. If the contractor prefers to set up their own washing facilities a site will be designated by PCA, the contractors staff should use biodegradable soaps and follow the principles of no trace camping. A cook and food will be provided by PCA. There is no running water on site, all water comes from the Nahanni River and water is filtered for drinking.

2. Section 01 11 00 Page 2 of 4, 1.4 Contractors Responsibilities; remove item # 5 and #12:

5. Provide food, lodging, and cooking facilities for own workers for the duration of the project; PC will provide camp sites, food storage and outhouses.
