 - .5 November 19, 2018 Complete design development report of preferred option.
 - .6 December 10, 2018 33% design review.
 - .7 January 7, 2019 66% design review.
 - .9 January 28, 2019 99% design review.
 - .10 February 11, 2019 100% (Final) Drawings and Specifications ready for Tender.
 - .11 February 18, 2019 Construction public tender call/bid evaluation.
 - .12 March 18, 2019 Contract award.

B) QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1 Please confirm Appendix E (Project Brief) item **2.3 Project Schedule** – appears work is due before solicitation closes?

A1 See tender package revisions above.

Q2 Please confirm and describe specific requirements outlined in Appendix E (Project Brief) item 3.2.2.6 Language Adaptation. Language adaptation applies to which deliverables specifically? **R2** Language adaptation applies to all deliverables that would be viewed at Peyto Lake by public / tourists, such as signage and maps.

Q3 Please confirm; Appendix E (Project Brief) items **3.2.2.4** and **3.2.2.5** are missing? **R3** Administrative error. Omit items **3.2.2.4** and **3.2.2.5**.

Q4 Site Closure. Would Parks be able to close the Peyto Lake site to public in order to complete the land survey and geotechnical investigation for the pre-design report? Is there a planned date for this? **A4** No, the site will need to remain open. It is suggested that this work be completed early in the morning when visitor traffic is at its lowest.

Q5 Viewpoint Scope. Is Parks looking to expand the viewpoint structure? We believe it will be challenging for a geotechnical investigation to be done in this location, will we be expected to complete a new investigation in this area? Is there as-builds available for the structure? Are there existing geotechnical

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reports that could be used for design if the structure needs to be expanded or if a new structure needs to be built?

A5 There is a design drawing available but no as builts for the viewpoint structure, see DSP 2_18-0100. Parks is looking to expand the viewpoint structure as well as subside safety concerns for visitors. A new geotechnical investigation must be completed as there are no existing geotechnical reports available.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
