AMENDMENT 004

This amendment is raised to publish questions and answers as follows:

Question 003:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.19 – Paint – The vehicle <i>must</i> be painted using commercial colours having a high-durability, corrosion-resistant type coating.
	Are the manufacturer's standard commercial colors (red and grey) of the forklift components accepted?
Answer 003:	Yes – manufacturer's standard commercial colors is acceptable for this application.
Question 004:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.2.1 – Weather – The vehicle <i>must</i> start and operate under weather conditions found in Canada in temperatures ranging from -40 to 40°C (-40 to 104°F).
	Our forklift is certified to operate to -30°C, please confirm if-30C will work. If not, more testing will be needed.
Answer 004:	No – an operating temp of -30°C is not acceptable for this application.
Question 005:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.3.1 – Noise Level – The vehicle noise levels <i>must</i> meet the requirements of legislation relative to paragraph 7.4 of Canada Occupational Safety and Health Regulations both at the operator's station and exterior to the vehicle for exposures of eight (8) hours during a 24-hours period when measured in accordance with CAN/CSA Z107.56-13.
	This requirement is defined in two ways:
	 The machine must not emit over 85dB; our machine, at high idle and driving, is 105dB; or
	 a sliding scale of decibel levels over time. A machine will operate over a varying range of decibel readings from idle to lifting to driving. A typical use cycle would have to be established to determine pass or fail. We are also measuring sound levels next Wednesday to help evaluate pass or fail.
	How do you define dB levels during the cycle? It does change during the working cycle.
Answer 005:	The forklift must meet paragraph 7.4 of Canada Occupational Safety and Health Regulations both at the operator's station and exterior to the vehicle for exposures of eight (8) hours during a 24-hours period when measured in accordance with CAN/CSA Z107.56-13.

Question 006:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.3.2 – Vehicle Safety – All vehicle design, construction and safety aspects <i>must</i> be in accordance with the latest edition of ANSI/ITDSF B56.6.
	We comply with ANSI/ITDSF B56.14 (B56.6 was the old standard. The new standard is B56.14). Will we comply with this section by complying with B56.14?
Answer 006:	Yes – compliant to ANSI/ITDSF B56.14 is acceptable. Please consult Section 2.2 of the Purchase Description for the information on the edition/effective documents.
Question 007:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.3.3(a) – "D" Safety Rating – The vehicle <i>must</i> be manufactured to meet the requirements of a "D" rating in accordance with standard UL 558 or North American <i>equivalent</i> .
	In lieu of UL558, is B56.14 is acceptable? Or do you require the supplier to comply with a certain section of UL558?
Answer 007:	The forklift must have fire safety protection compliant to UL558.
Question 008:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.5.1(a) i – Mast – The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with a telescopic, see-through, hydraulic vertical mast having a minimum 8-degree forward tilt capability and minimum 6-degree backward tilt capability. These tilt capacities are measured from the mast, vertical straight up position.
	By "telescopic see-through hydraulic vertical mast", please clarify exactly what type of mast you are looking for.
Answer 008:	The mast required must be vertical having forward and backward tilt and must be able to vertically extend up and collapse down using hydraulic mechanism. It also must provide a clear view to the operator through the mast structure/frame for safe operation of the vehicle.
Question 009:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.5.1(f) – Forks Positioner – The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with a fork-positioning system.
	Are you looking for an Integrated Fork Positioner that can be operated by a lever by the operator?
Answer 009:	Integrated side shifting with Fork Positioner is preferable but individual side shift and fork positioning functions also are acceptable.
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Question 010:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.5.1(g) – Vandal Protection – The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with vandal protection including provisions for locking engine covers, filler caps and the cab with padlocks or an <i>equivalent</i> .
Answer 010:	No – a soft vinyl cab is not acceptable for this application.
Question 011:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.5.1(h) i – Tool Compartment - The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with secure storage for all tools and loose equipment required for daily maintenance.
	Please specify the location on the machine.
Answer 011:	A manufacturer's standard tool compartment location is acceptable for this application.
Question 012:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.6.2 – Removable Cab – The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with a soft removable cab.
	We offer an optional removable vinyl cab cover. Please confirm if this is acceptable.
Answer 012:	A removable vinyl cab is not acceptable for this application. The user confirmed that a hard cap is required. Please consult amendment on the Purchase Description (see RFP Amendment No. 2).
Question 013:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.8.2(a) – Engine Cold Weather Aids - The engine <i>must</i> be provided with cold weather aids to enable the engine to be started at temperatures down to -40°C (may include glow plugs or intake air preheat system).
	Our engine starts are certified to -30°C (tender is requesting -40°C) – please see our previous question in section 3.2.1.
Answer 013:	See answer 004 relating to Annex "B" – Purchase Description, Paragraph 3.2.1.
Question 014:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.11.1 – Steering – The vehicle steering system <i>must</i> be standard power-assisted steering which <i>must</i> conform to CAN/CSA B335-04 or an <i>equivalent</i> .
	A review of CAN/CSA B335-04 appears very similar to USA ANSI B56.14, which the TMT does conform to. The only sub clause of CAN/CSA B335-04 that appears to be related to steering is 4.5.7 General Ergonomic Principles, which the TMT does appear to conform to. Please confirm that it is adequate to comply with B56.14.
Answer 014:	A steering system compliant to ANSI B56.14 will be acceptable for this application.

Question 015:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.11.2 – Steering – The steering system <i>must</i> be provided with an adjustable (tilt and telescopic) steering column. We have a fixed steering column. Is this acceptable.
Answer 015:	No – a forklift without tilt and telescopic steering will not be acceptable for this application.
Question 016:	Annex "B" – Purchase Description, paragraph 3.16.3(c)(d)(e) – Signal/Work Lights – The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with rear mounted stop lights. The vehicle <i>must</i> be provided with front and rear mounted turn signal lights. The signal light control <i>must</i> be mounted on the steering column.
	The stop lights, front and rear turn signals, are not currently designed. Currently, there are no accommodations electrically to add option. Is it acceptable not to have road lights? We currently do not offer this as an option from factory.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN UNCHANGED.

No – a forklift without signal/work lights will not be acceptable for this application.
