**.2** Unspecified Material shall be reimbursed at net cost, as supported by invoices, plus Markup as established in the Price Schedule of this Offer. "Net Cost" means all amounts reasonably and properly paid by the Offeror in respect of materials required for and used in the Work, and includes packing, handling and delivery charges, less any trade discounts received by the Offeror.
