



Question and Answer 8 to 9

Question 8, referring to question 1

Q8. There is no such item available on the SA, and supplying a 24" deep unit against the GoCUID provided would be non-compliant to the SA. Would you consider switching that item to the Non-SA section to get the 24" deep unit you require?

A8. We would like this unit to be 24" deep, even if it is non-SA

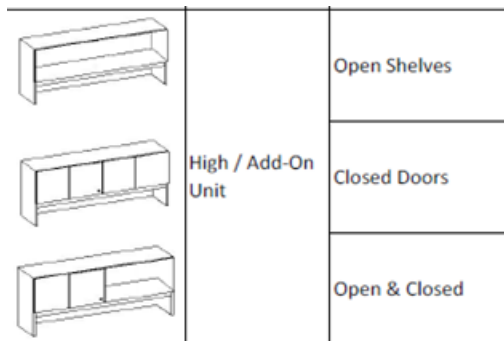
Q1. Item #2 calls for a 24" depth storage product. However, the GoCUID SPHIOS508xxCH0762xxxx outlined under item #2 actually references a 20" depth storage product. Please confirm if 20" depth is the requirement.

A1. We require it to be 24" deep so that it aligns nicely with item 3, as well as the work surface. It will also be used to support the hutch if we are supplied with a wall mounted unit instead of the desk mounted hutch.

Question 9, referring to question 5

Q9. It is not structurally sound to mount overhead storage to freestanding storage as you have described. If the overhead cannot be wall mounted, you have states a Hutch (desk mounted) can be provided. Hutches are available on the SA, with specific GoCUID's to determine the configuration (open, open/closed, or closed, as per image below). Tackboard below the hutch would need to be requested as a non-SA item.

Q5. The wall mount storage hutch under the Non-SA items - please provide more details (eg. open or with doors, style, etc).

A5. This item is not going to be wall hung; it needs to be supported by the wardrobe on one side, and the file cabinet/shelving combination on the other side. We would like it to have four doors, but will also accept two doors with open shelving. We would like a tack board beneath the hutch. We would also be happy with a desk mounted unit instead.
